The AQMD appreciates the participation of the dryc 1421-Control of Perchloroethylene (Perc) Emissions. Adopting this rule is a very important step in AQMD's effort to reduce air conta cleaners to convert to new methods and to help ease to new equipment, AQMD has committed \$2 million in grants to provide financial assistance to drycleaners converting to new equipment.

Financial incentives for the purchase of new non-pe rc alternative dry cleaning technologies are limited to professional wet cleaning ng, CO 2 cleaning, and hydrocarbon or other non-perc solvent cleaning equipment. Under t his program, grant money will be available to dry cleaning facility owners presentin g purchase orders (or purchase agreements) for new non-perc alternatives to replac e existing perc machines or to be added to a facility. Grants are limited to one per grant program. Amount of the financial incentives for the non-percal ternatives are:

- Each approved professional wet cleaning or CO <sub>2</sub> cleaning system will receive a grantnottoexceed \$10,000.
- Eachapprovedhydrocarbonsolventdrycleaningequ ipmentwillreceiveagrant nottoexceed\$5,000.

With consideration of the Environmental Justice fun status will be determined by date stamping the appl financial incentive grant will only be approved if alternative cleaning equipment agrees to the terms AQMD. Verification of a non-perc alternative insta money is distributed to a grant recipient. Please and Operate or Permits to Operate are required for hydrocarbon dry cleaning machines. Grant applicati beapproved only after the permits are granted.
