Kargul is Director of Technology Transfer in the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency's Clean Automotive Technology program, based in the Advanced Technology Division at the National Vehicle and Fuel Emissions Laboratory in Ann Arbor, Michigan. He has worked for the EPA since the early 1970's and currently has a key leadership role in transferring the Agency's hybrid technology to the automotive and trucking industry through cooperative research and licensing agreements. John is involved in several hydraulic hybrid demonstration programs for both light and heavy-duty vehicles. He is particularly interested in the benefits that hydraulic hybrids deliver to clean the environment, reduce dependence on imported oil, increase economic growth, and enhance national security.
