

Trinity River Restoration Program

Project Description

The channel rehabilitation aspect of the Trinity River Restoration Program (TRRP) involves restoring and maintaining the channels at 44 locations along the Trinity River. Of the sites to be rehabilitated in 2010, four include these restoration activities: floodplain lowering/re-contouring, side channel development, gravel augmentation, large woody debris placement, riparian establishment and other habitat enhancement activities.

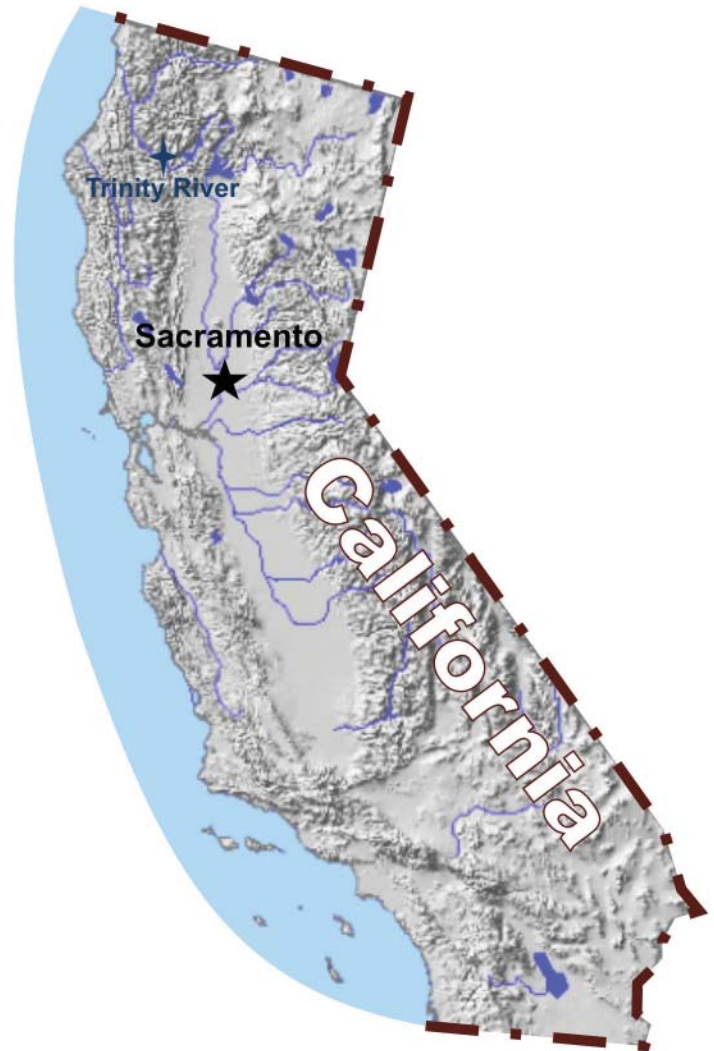
Project Benefits
