SUPPLEMENTARY INFORMATION: The Commission instituted this investigation, which concerns allegations of unfair acts in violation of section 337 in the importation and sale of certain encapsulated integrated circuit devices and products containing same thereof on December, 19, 2003, based on a complaint filed by Amkor Technology, Inc, ("Amkor") of West Chester, Pennsylvania. The respondents named in the notice of investigation are Carsem (M) Sdn Bhp, Ipoh, Perak, Malaysia; Carsem, Inc., of City of Industry, CA (collectively "Carsem").

Amkor's complaint alleged that Carsem's products infringe claims of three patents held by Carsem.

On June 7, 2004, the presiding ALJ issued Order No. 63 granting respondents Carsem's request to certify to the Commission a request for judicial enforcement of a subpoena issued by the ALJ to non-party ASAT Inc.

This action is taken under the authority of section 337 of the Tariff Act of 1930, 19 U.S.C. § 1337, and Commission rule 210.32(g), 19 C.F.R. § 210.32(g).
