## LEMON JUICE FROM ARGENTINA AND MEXICO

AGENCY: United States International Trade Commission.

**ACTION**: Suspension of investigations.

<u>SUMMARY</u>: On September 21, 2007, the Department of Commerce published notice in the *Federal Register* of the suspension of its antidumping investigations on lemon juice from Argentina and Mexico (72 FR 53991 and 72 FR 53995, respectively). Both suspension agreements took effect on September 10, 2007. The suspensions are based upon agreements between Commerce and producers/exporters which account for substantially all imports of this product from Argentina and Mexico, in which each signatory producer/exporter agreed to revise its prices to eliminate completely the injurious effects of exports of this merchandise to the United States. Accordingly, the U.S. International Trade Commission gives notice of the suspension of its antidumping investigations involving imports from Argentina and Mexico of lemon juice, provided for in subheadings 2009.31.40, 2009.31.60, and 2009.39.60 of the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States.
