The Millennium Challenge Corporation (MCC) is a new U.S. Government corporation, with headquarters in the Washington DC metropolitan area, that provides incentive-based foreign assistance in support of economic growth and poverty reduction. The MCC is seeking short-term, intermittent consulting services from experts on a wide-range of topics in economics and economic development. Candidates should be recognized experts in their field with a significant publication record. Examples of topics include evaluation of proposals from foreign countries that raise difficult economic issues requiring further study, assessment of experience on similar projects in other countries, original data gathering and analysis, and rigorous impact assessments.

Consulting services will be requested in the form of short-term technical assistance that could range from a half a day to two months in duration. The MCC is inviting interested persons or groups to submit CV's and a brief cover letter describing their areas of expertise. The response should address proposed consultant rates on an hourly basis. The MCC will select multiple sources to provide economic analysis consulting services on an intermittent basis.

This announcement is not restricted to U.S. citizens. Persons will be selected by MCC and contracted through a third party who will handle payrolling and administration for all Designated Consultants. Individual assignments could range from a few days to 12 months in duration. Compensation will be based on experience. The MCC will select multiple sources to provide these services. There will be no commitment to a minimum or maximum amount of work after the award of a contract.

There is no commitment to a minimum or maximum amount of work implied by submitting an application nor there be a guaranteed quantity of work implied by being accepted by the MCC.
