The enclosed booklet, "Federal Branches and Agencies Supervision," is part of an ongoing update and revision of the *Comptroller's Handbook*. The booklet revises and updates section 701 of the "*Comptroller's Handbook for National Bank Examiners*." The key objectives of this booklet are to:

- Articulate supervision-by-risk policies to suit the structure and operation of federal branches and agencies.
- Explain and apply OCC's supervisory process for federal branches and agencies in the context
  of OCC's participation in the interagency framework for supervising U.S. branches and
  agencies of foreign banks.
- Highlight special considerations to guide examination efforts in federal branches and
  agencies, emphasizing that they are not stand-alone units but operations whose condition and
  viability depend on the financial and managerial support of their parent banks.
