The enclosed booklet, "Sampling Methodologies," is part of an ongoing update and revision of the *Comptroller's Handbook*. The booklet updates and replaces the "Statistical Sampling" section of the *Comptroller's Handbook for National Bank Examiners*. Significant changes reflected in the revised booklet include: more examiner discretion in selecting sampling methodologies and related precision and reliability levels, guiding worksheets for proportional and numerical sampling, a more comprehensive glossary of sampling terminology, and general examination procedures for proportional and numerical sampling. The booklet sets out general OCC policy and guidance on the use of sampling as a tool for assessing the quality of risk management practices and quantity of risk for various areas of bank examination interest. It establishes general OCC policy and guidance for sampling, both statistical and nonstatistical.

The "Sampling Methodologies" booklet discusses:

- Objectives of a supervisory activity and how they relate to the selection of an appropriate method of sampling.
- The sampling methods judgmental, proportional, numerical that can be used and suggested applications of statistical sampling, and the basic elements precision, reliability, and sampling risk associated with statistical sampling methodologies.
- Concepts of sampling plans population selection, sample design and selection, and evaluation and interpretation including using sample results in probability statements and examination comments. Examples, worksheets, and procedures are provided to help with selection, design, evaluation, and interpretation.
