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CEMENT IN OCTOBER 2008

This report provides monthly data on the shipments of cement to final customers, and the production of clinker, in the United States from January 2007 through the current month.¹ The current report contains extensive revisions to the data for, primarily, northern California and Puerto Rico. Data on the imports of cement and clinker for the current month are also provided.

Total shipments of portland and blended cement in the United States and Puerto Rico for October 2008 were about 9.2 million metric tons (Mt). This was about 16% lower than shipments in October 2007 (tables 2A and 2B). Year-to-date shipments were about 84.0 Mt, down by about 14% from those of the same period in 2007. The leading producing States (Texas, California, Michigan, Missouri, and Pennsylvania, in descending order) shipped about 37% of the October total (table 1A). The leading consuming States (Texas, California, Florida, Illinois, and Ohio, in descending order) received about 35% of October's total shipments (tables 2A and 2B).

Clinker production totaled about 7.0 Mt, about 7% lower than the production in October 2007 (table 4). Year-to-date

production was 67.8 Mt, down by about 7% compared with that of the same period in 2007. The leading clinker-producing States (California, Texas, Pennsylvania, Alabama, and Missouri, in descending order) produced about 42% of the October total.

Masonry cement shipments in October of about 264,000 metric tons were about 28% lower than shipments for October 2007 (table 2C). Year-to-date shipments were 2.70 Mt, down by about 28% from those of the same period in 2007. The leading consuming States in October, in descending order, were Florida, Texas, California, North Carolina, and Georgia, and these States received about 45% of October's total shipments.

Tables 5, 6, and 7 contain import data from the U.S. Census Bureau. Data for clinker imports into the Seattle and possibly the Detroit customs districts are likely incomplete owing to some shipments arriving overland from Canada on an informal entry basis. October 2008 imports of cement and clinker were about 0.9 Mt, down by about 53% from imports in October 2007. Year-to-date imports were 10.0 Mt, down by about 49%.
