CEMENT IN FEBRUARY 2009

This report provides monthly data on the shipments of cement to final customers, and the production of clinker, in the United States from January 2008 through the current month.¹ Data on the imports of cement and clinker for the current month are also provided.

Total shipments of portland and blended cement in the United States and Puerto Rico for February 2009 were about 4.6 million metric tons (Mt). This was almost 27% lower than shipments in February 2008 (tables 2A and 2B). Year-to-date shipments were about 9.0 Mt, down by almost 29%. The leading producing States (Texas, California, Alabama, Florida, and Missouri, in descending order) shipped about 45% of the February total (table 1A). The leading consuming States (Texas, California, Florida, Louisiana, and Georgia, in descending order) received almost 44% of February's total shipments (tables 2A and 2B).

Clinker production totaled about 4.4 Mt, about 18% lower than the production in February 2008 (table 4). Year-to-date production was nearly 9.0 Mt, down by about 23%. The leading clinker-producing States (Texas, California, Missouri, Florida,

and Alabama, in descending order) produced about 46% of the February total.

Masonry cement shipments in February of nearly 155,000 metric tons (t) were about 30% lower than shipments for February 2008 (table 2C). Year-to-date shipments were about 299,000 t, down by almost 36%. The leading consuming States in February, in descending order, were Florida, Texas, California, North Carolina, and Georgia, and these States received about 52% of February's total shipments.

Tables 5, 6, and 7 contain import data from the U.S. Census Bureau. Data for clinker imports into the Seattle and possibly the Detroit customs districts are likely incomplete owing to some shipments arriving overland from Canada on an informal entry basis. February 2009 imports of cement and clinker were nearly 431,000 t, down by about 47% from imports in February 2008. Year-to-date imports were almost 824,000 t, down by about 55%.
