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CEMENT IN APRIL 2009

This report provides monthly data on the shipments of cement to final customers, and the production of clinker, in the United States from January 2008 through the current month.¹ Data on the imports of cement and clinker for the current month are also provided.

Total shipments of portland and blended cement in the United States and Puerto Rico for April 2009 were about 6.0 million metric tons (Mt). This was about 32% lower than shipments in April 2008 (tables 2A and 2B). Year-to-date shipments were about 20.3 Mt, down by about 29%. The leading producing States (Texas, California, Pennsylvania, Missouri, and Alabama, in descending order) shipped about 40% of the April total (table 1A). The leading consuming States (Texas, California, Florida, New York, and Illinois, in descending order) received almost 37% of April's total shipments (tables 2A and 2B).

Clinker production totaled 4.7 Mt, 28.5% lower than the production in April 2008 (table 4). Year-to-date production was 18.3 Mt, down by nearly 27%. The leading clinker-producing

States (California, Texas, Alabama, Indiana, and Missouri, in descending order) produced about 46% of the April total.

Masonry cement shipments in April of about 191,000 metric tons (t) were almost 37% lower than shipments for April 2008 (table 2C). Year-to-date shipments were about 680,000 t, down by almost 34%. The leading consuming States in April, in descending order, were Florida, Texas, California, North Carolina, and Georgia, and these States received nearly 49% of April's total shipments.

Tables 5, 6, and 7 contain import data from the U.S. Census Bureau. Data for clinker imports into the Seattle and possibly the Detroit customs districts are likely incomplete owing to some shipments arriving overland from Canada on an informal entry basis. April 2009 imports of cement and clinker were about 613,000 t, down by about 47% from imports in April 2008. Year-to-date imports were about 1.8 Mt, down by almost 53%.
