Came on to be considered the United States' Verified Complaint and Request For Temporary Restraining Order and Permanent Injunction. The Court having been advised that the parties have reached an agreement in the above-referenced matter. It is therefore

ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that Brian Bicknell, in his own name or in any other capacity, will immediately stop aiding, assisting, advising, or preparing for compensation of federal income tax returns of third-party taxpayers. It is further

ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that Brian Bicknell will disclose to the United States of America, by and through its attorneys, Louise P. Hytken/Gregg Stevens, the names, addresses and social security or tax identification numbers of all his clients and of all persons whom federal income tax returns he has prepared for the tax years 1990 to the date of the Court's order, inclusive. ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that Brian Bicknell identify and provide to the Internal Revenue Service all documents in his possession or under his control which relate to those individuals described in the above paragraph. It is further



ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that Bicknell notify, in writing, all persons whose income tax returns he has prepared from 1987 to the date of this Court's order, inclusive, of the findings and relief ordered by this Court, including in such notice to each person a copy of this Complaint and of the Court's Final Order of Permanent Injunction; and that Bicknell file with the Court a list of the names and addresses of all persons so notified within 90 days of the date the Order is entered.

This Court will retain jurisdiction of this matter to enforce this order.
