AFI 44-102 notes:

1.14.2. Personnel may register or re-register with either the American Heart Association (AHA) or the American Red Cross (ARC).

1.18.1. The MDG/CC designates an individual to coordinate BLS provider/instructor training for DoD affiliated, area organizations that are otherwise unable to provide this training. Organizations requesting this training provide funding and course materials.

BUMED instruction 1500.15a notes:

3.b DoD defines BLS as the training specified by the AHA or ARC

7.b Use of the MTN is recommended unless other means of obtaining training are more efficient and cost effective.

AR 40-68 notes: (Chapter 5) notes:

5e1. Administrative, maintenance, housekeeping, and other non-patient care personnel do not require BLS unless directed by the MTF commander.

5e2. The Physicians, PAs, NPs, and RNs assigned to the emergency department/service will possess ACLS, ATLS, PALS, and BLS. Other health care personnel (medical/dental requiring ACLS, ATLS or PALS) are at the discretion of the MTF commander.

5e3. PAs assigned to all TOE units are encouraged to obtain ACLS certification.
