A **Private Sector Security Overseas Seminar (PSOS)** will be offered on March 30-31, 2009 at the Foreign Service Institute.

Taking part in these intensive briefings provides participants with the same security awareness training that is mandated for all official U.S. mission employees before their deployment. This two-day primer provides guidance for personal choices on security overseas. The focus is on getting participants to identify security risks and develop strategies for dealing with them. For the Private Sector, it also provides a benchmark on what the government requires of its overseas employees.
