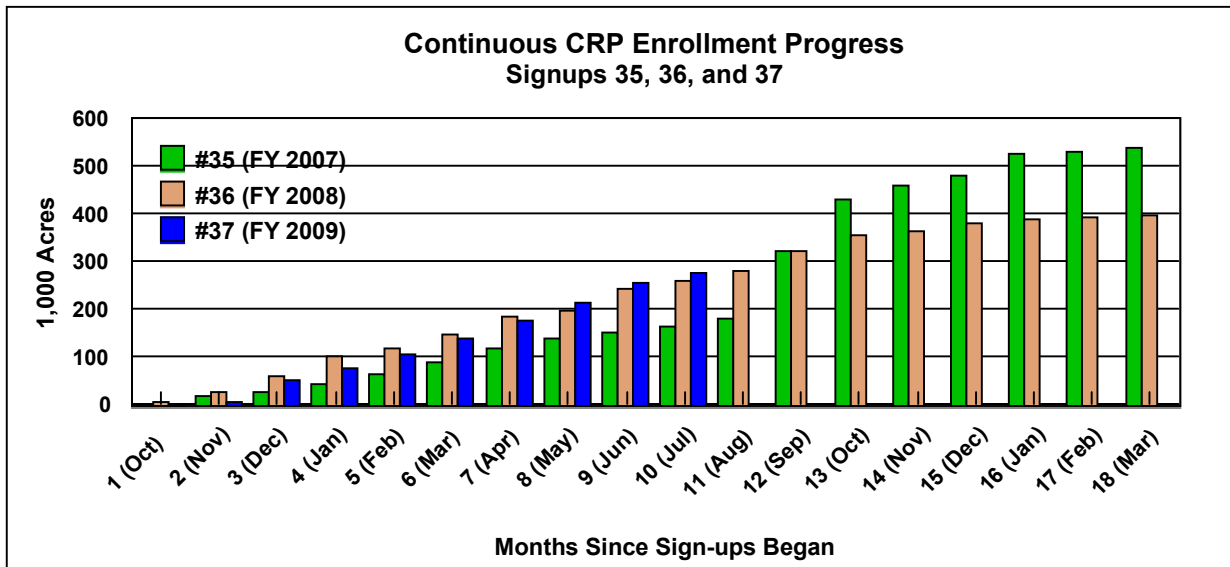

CRP ENROLLMENT ACTIVITY AND NEWS – July 2009

- So far, contract extensions on about 800,000 acres have been recorded for contracts set to expire September 30, 2009. Extension offers were made on 1.5 million expiring acres.
- Sign-up 37 (FY 2009 continuous sign-up) added 19,000 acres in July and now stands at 276,000 acres, compared with last year’s 262,000 acres through July.
- Overall, enrollment increased 15,000 acres during July as continuous signup increased 19,000 acres while general signup decreased 4,000 acres.
- Land currently under contract, 33.73 million acres, is down 0.88 million acres from last year’s 34.61 million acres (page 16).
- The current contract expiration schedule is provided (pages 14 and 15). It shows that 2.5 million acres expired September 30, 2007, and 1.2 million acres expired September 30, 2008. Some of these lands have been re-enrolled as continuous sign-up practices.
- The expiring contract table reflects some of the changes resulting from the 3- and 5-year extension offered for contracts expiring 9/30/2009.
- Results of Emergency Forestry CRP signup have been updated (page 3). There are now 286,000 acceptable acres with total rental payments of \$83 million.

General Signup. Producers with eligible lands compete nationally for acceptance based on an environmental benefits index (EBI) during specified enrollment periods. Producers may submit offers below soil-specific maximum rental rates and select wildlife-enhancing vegetative covers to increase EBI ranking.

Continuous (Non-CREP) Sign-up. Producers with eligible lands may enroll certain high priority conservation practices, such as filter strips and riparian buffers, at any time during the year without competition. In addition to annual soil rental payment and cost-share assistance, many practices are eligible for additional annual and one-time up-front financial incentives. Land enrolled under various initiatives are included in this category.

Conservation Reserve Enhancement Program (CREP). Under CREP agreements, Federal/State partnerships, implement projects designed to address specific environmental objectives through targeted CRP enrollments. Sign-up is held on a continuous basis, general sign-up practices may be included, and additional financial incentives are generally provided. Currently, there are 43 agreements in 32 States.

Farmable Wetland Program (FWP). Producers enroll small non-flood plain wetlands under modified continuous sign-up provisions.

The accompanying tables are based on contract data developed and maintained in CRP data files by USDA Service Centers through July 31, 2009, and are based on the physical location of the CRP contracted land. Some adjustments have been made to correct mis-coded data in the active contract files.

Note: Contracts re-enrolled under 2006's re-enrollment and extension offer (REX) are not considered to expire when the current contracts expire, because new contracts will begin immediately after expiration.
