- Specific Procurement Notices are published on the IDB web site at http://www.iadb.org/procurement¹. These notices provide information for businesses seeking procurement opportunities on IDB-financed projects. Information on the Bank's entire portfolio of projects, including project description and status, the names of the executing agency and IDB team leader, financial data, and project documents, is at http://www.iadb.org/projects².
- Both pipeline (projects in preparation phase) and approved projects are included, and contract award and procurement notice information for approved projects can be found there.
- There are three ways to search on the IDB website:
 - 1. Procurement RSS
 - 2. Project
 - 3. Country

PROJECT CYCLE




Procurement RSS

- Procurement RSS is a search that is normally used to locate new projects in IDB.
- You can use this search by clicking on the link from the the IDB's homepage on the lower left hand side of the screen.


From there:

1. Click on <u>Project</u> <u>Pipeline</u> to see those projects that have not yet been approved by the Board of Executive Directors. These projects are in the preparation phase and therefore the best opportunities for potential investors.




Country Search


• You can then scroll through the procurements and pick out projects from different sectors.
