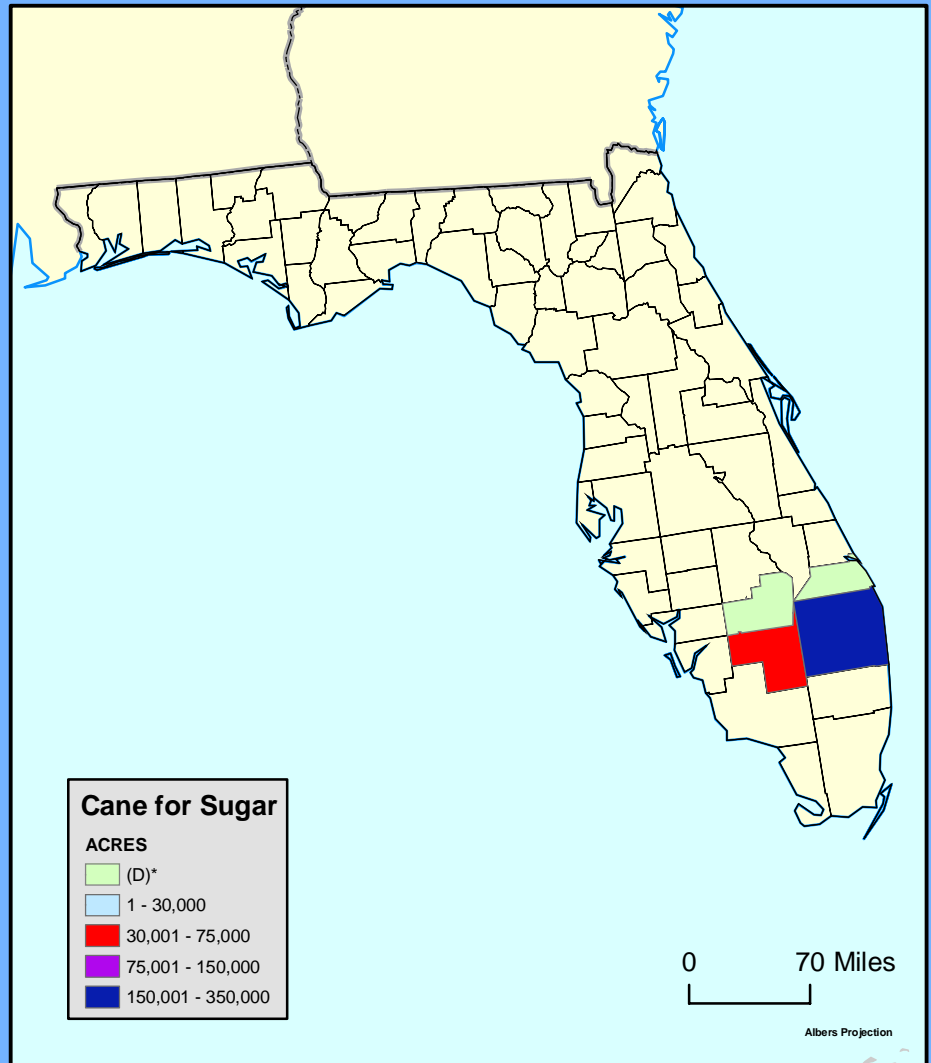


Sugar Contributes 8.7 percent to Florida's \$6.5 billion Farm Income
