

Imports and Exports  
of Fishery Products  
Annual Summary, 2000

IMPORTS. U.S. imports of edible fishery products in 2000 were valued at \$10.1 billion, \$1.0 billion higher than in 1999. The quantity of edible imports was 1,804,517 metric tons, a 40,981 ton increase from the quantity imported in 1999.

The quantity of shrimp imported in 2000 was 345,076 tons, 13,369 tons more than the quantity imported in 1999. Valued at \$3.8 billion, shrimp imports accounted for 37 percent of the value of total edible imports. Imports of salmon, including fillets, were 146,095 tons valued at \$804.5 million in 2000. Imports of fresh and frozen tuna were 201,947 tons, 20,771 tons less than imported in 1999. Imports of canned tuna were 141,961 tons, 9,784 tons less than in 1999. Imports of fresh and frozen fillets and steaks amounted to 333,263 tons, an increase of 36,474 tons from 1999. Regular and minced block imports were 92,490 tons, a decrease of 4,739 tons from 1999. Edible imports consisted: of 1,501,575 tons of fresh and frozen products valued at \$9.1 billion; 252,332 tons of canned products valued at \$670.1 million; 31,250 tons of cured products valued at \$144.8 million; 2,603 tons of caviar and roe products valued at \$45.8 million; and 16,757 tons of other products valued at \$73.6 million.

Imports of nonedible fishery products were valued at \$8.9 billion, \$933.7 million higher than imported in 1999. Total value of edible and nonedible products resulted in a record import value of \$19.0 billion in 2000, \$2.0 billion higher than in 1999, when \$17.0 billion of fishery products were imported.

EXPORTS. U.S. exports of edible fishery products of domestic origin were 948,025 tons valued at \$2.8 billion, compared with 864,166 tons at \$2.7 billion exported in 1999.

Fresh and frozen items were 806,781 tons valued at \$2.1 billion, an increase of 81,731 tons and \$46.1 million compared with 1999. Fresh and frozen exports consisted principally of 98,206 tons of salmon valued at \$345.4 million, 28,537 tons of lobster (*Homarus* spp.) valued at \$281.8 million, and 147,517 tons of surimi valued at \$279.9 million. Canned items were 69,977 tons valued at \$213.9 million. Salmon was the major canned item exported, with 36,706 tons valued at \$145.9 million. Cured items were 4,747 tons valued at \$17.7 million. Caviar and roe exports were 40,643 tons valued at \$416.7 million. Other edible products accounted for 25,877 tons valued at \$41.2 million.

Exports of nonedible products were valued at \$6.9 billion. Exports of fish meal amounted to 89,313 tons valued at \$67.8 million. The total value of edible and nonedible exports was \$9.7 billion, \$983.3 million more than in 1999.

RE-EXPORTS. U.S. exports of edible fishery products of foreign origin were 37,402 tons valued at \$160.3 million, compared to 25,393 tons valued at \$116.0 million re-exported in 1999. Fresh and frozen items were 30,220 tons valued at \$135.2 million an increase of 7,303 tons and \$29.1 million compared with 1999. Fresh and frozen shrimp was the principle product at 4,095 tons valued at \$37.9 million. Canned items accounted for 2,594 tons valued at \$4.9 million. Cured products were 1,578 tons valued at \$2.1 million. Caviar and roe re-exports were 2,495 tons valued at \$17.1 million. Other edible products were 515 tons valued at \$1.0 million.

Re-exports of nonedible fishery products were valued at \$999.4 million. Fish oils accounted for 215 tons valued at \$396 thousand and fish meal amounting to 5,569 tons valued at \$7.5 million. The total value of edible and nonedible re-exports was \$1.2 billion, \$91.2 million less than in 1999.

NOTES. Unless otherwise noted, the information presented is based on Bureau of the Census data for the Customs territory of the United States. The territory includes the 50 states, District of Columbia, Puerto Rico, and the U.S. Virgin Islands.

Imports for consumption are a combination of entries into the U.S. for immediate consumption and withdrawals from Customs bonded warehouses for consumption. These data reflect the actual entry into U.S. consumption channels of commodities that originated outside the United States.

Exports may include merchandise of both domestic and foreign origin. Census defines exports of "domestic" merchandise to include commodities which are grown, produced, or manufactured in the United States. For statistical purposes, domestic exports also include commodities of foreign origin which have been changed in the U.S. from the form in which they were imported, or which have been enhanced in value by further manufacture in the United States.

Re-exports of "foreign" products are commodities which have entered the U.S. as imports and not sold, which, at the time of re-export, are in substantially the same condition as when imported. Items imported for sale in the U.S. but later resold overseas, however, are recorded as exports of domestic goods rather than as re-exports.

A product of foreign origin is transformed into a domestic good when the imported item loses its foreign identity through further substantial manufacture. This transformation generally produces a good with a different trade classification. For example, fish sticks cut from imported fish blocks, when exported to a foreign country, are classified as domestic for statistical purposes.

The value of imports presented is the "Customs value." It is based on the value of the product in the country of origin as appraised by the U.S. Customs Service, and excludes import duties, freight, insurance, and other charges incurred in bringing it to the United States. Export and re-export value is equivalent to f.a.s. (free alongside ship) at the port of export, based on the transaction price, including freight, insurance, and other charges incurred in placing the merchandise alongside the carrier. The value excludes the cost of loading, freight and subsequent insurance.
