Included in this e-mail transmission is a copy of the CSREES-OD-1088-C, Distribution of the Public Law 95-113, Section 1445, funding for the Evans-Allen Program at the 1890 Land-Grant Institutions, including Tuskegee University, and West Virginia State University for FY 2007. The distribution was calculated using the 2000 Census Data. The distribution also identifies funds for the Small Business Innovation Research Program, reflecting the requirement that not less than 2.50 percent of the funds be set aside for that purpose in FY 2007. Additionally, the distribution also identifies a set-aside for biotechnology risk assessment.

A Planning and Reporting page has been established on our website to assist you in locating the requirements, due dates, and submission information for the Evans-Allen Program formula funds and all other formula funds. The research and extension formulas are organized in groups for the three land-grant types: 1890 Land-Grant Institutions, 1862 Land-Grant Institutions in the U.S. Territories, and 1862 Land-Grant Institutions. Since funding continues to be contingent upon meeting planning and reporting requirements, you may want to have your administrative staff bookmark the following web link for easy access to fillable forms and due dates for all formula funds:
