THE AMERICAN RECOVERY AND **REINVESTMENT ACT (STIMULUS BILL) AVAILABLE ON GPO'S FEDERAL DIGITAL SYSTEM**

WASHINGTON—The U.S. Government Printing Office (GPO) makes available the authentic version of The American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009, signed into law by President Barack Obama, on GPO's Federal Digital System (FDsys). GPO also authenticates the document by digital signature. This signature assures the public that the document has not been changed or altered. A digital signature, viewed through the GPO Seal of Authenticity, verifies the document's integrity and authenticity.

"GPO's Federal Digital System is the place to find authentic government information," said Public Printer Bob Tapella. "GPO is committed to providing Americans transparency on the workings of their government. Two key elements in managing federal documents on FDsys are versioning and authentication. Versioning lets the user know which version of a document is being presented and is important when viewing legislation and draft documents. Authentication is necessary to maintain a chain of custody from author to end user."

GPO launched FDsys in the last month. This system gives the American people a one-stop site to authentic, published government information. FDsys allows GPO to receive information from federal agencies in all three branches of government and create a repository for permanent, public access. More than 154,000 documents are currently accessible, with additional documents being added daily. FDsys offers incredible search capabilities for users such as: searching by Congressional Committee, a Member of Congress, keyword and date. FDsys will replace GPOAccess in mid-2009 and releases with additional functionality will occur throughout the next several years.
