

The rates for both days away from work (DAFW) cases and job transfer or restriction cases were higher in transportation and warehousing than in any other service-providing sector in 2006.

Health care and social assistance had the next-highest rate for DAFW cases.

The rate of DAFW cases was higher than the rate of job transfer or restriction cases in 12 of the 15 service-providing sectors. The two rates were relatively the same in wholesale trade, management of companies and enterprises, and arts, entertainment, and recreation.
