The following tables show amounts of Pacific halibut and sablefish available for the 2009 Individual Fishing Quota (IFQ) and Community Development Quota (CDQ) fisheries. Halibut amounts were adopted by the International Pacific Halibut Commission at its January, 2009 meeting, and reflect the catch sharing plan implemented by the North Pacific Fishery Management Council.
