NEW RESIDENTIAL CONSTRUCTION IN APRIL 2001

BUILDING PERMITS

Privitely-owned housing units authorized by building pemDts in April were It . seasonally adjusted annual rate of I, s87,000, according to estimates reported today by the U.S. Co~ Department's Census Bureau. 11ris is 2 (:i:I) percent below the revised March rate of 1,627,000 and is I (:i:I) percent below the revised April 2000 estimate of 1,s95,000.

Single-family authorizations in April 2001 were at. rate of 1,217,000; this is I (:1:1) percent above the March figure of 1,209,000. Authorizations of units in buildings with five units or more were at. rate 0£301,000 in April.

HOUSING STARTS

Privately-owned housing starts in April were at a seasonally adjusted annual rate of 1,609,000. This is I (:i: 7) percent above the revised March estimate of 1.586,000, but is 1 (:i:7) percent below the revised April 2000 rate of 1,626,000.

Single-family housing starts in April 2001 were at. me of 1,288,000; this is 7 (:t:6) percent above the March figure of 1,207,000. The April estimate for units in buildings with five units or nX>R was 280,000.

HOUSING COMPLETIONS

Privately-owned housing co~letions in April were at a seasonally adjusted annual rate of 1,533,000, according to estimates released jointly today by the U.S. Census Bureau and the U.S. Deparbnent of Housing and Urban Development. This is 5 (:t:8) percent above the revised March estimate of 1,464,000, but 5 (:t:8) percent below die April 2000 rate of 1,608,000.

Single-family housing completions in April 2001 were at a rate of 1,18S,IXX>; this is virtually unchanged (:9 percent) from the RVised March figure of 1,189,1XX>. The April rate for units in buildings with five units or nX>re was 319,000.
