The Securities and Exchange Commission (Commission) issued its Order Instituting Proceedings (OIP) on January 4, 2008. A hearing is scheduled for February 13, 2008.

The Division of Enforcement (Division) has provided evidence that all Respondents have received the OIP in a manner that complies with Rule 141(a)(2)(ii) of the Commission's Rules of Practice. However, one Respondent, ActFit.com, Inc., n/k/a Telum International Corp., was served in a foreign country. Accordingly, the Division also must provide evidence that the method of service used—attempted delivery by express mail—is not forbidden by the law of the foreign country. See Rule 141(a)(2)(iv) of the Commission's Rules of Practice.

The Division has requested that I schedule a telephonic prehearing conference with counsel for two Respondents. To date, however, only one such Respondent, Advanced Products Group, Inc., n/k/a Cloudtech Sensors, Inc., has filed an Answer. Advanced Products Group/Cloudtech intends to defend on the grounds that it engaged a new independent auditor in August 2007, and that it is attempting in good faith to file all overdue periodic reports. In these circumstances, Advanced Products Group/Cloudtech should make arrangements for its independent auditor to participate in the telephonic prehearing conference, so that he/she may answer questions from the Division and the undersigned about the progress of the audit. If AdPads, Inc., wishes to participate in the telephonic prehearing conference, it must first submit its Answer to the OIP.

IT IS ORDERED THAT, on or before February 8, 2008, Respondents Accent Color Sciences, Inc., AdPads, Inc., Aero Group, Inc., and Alford Refrigerated Warehouses, Inc., shall show cause why each of them should not be held in default for failure to file timely Answers and why the registrations of their registered securities should not be revoked. Any response to this Order must include the overdue Answers to the OIP; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED THAT the Division and Respondent Advanced Products Group/Cloudtech shall make arrangements for a telephonic prehearing conference at a time when the independent auditor for Advanced Products Group/Cloudtech can participate.
