COMMENTS REQUESTED ON AMENDMENTS TO EXTEND TIME PERIOD IN EXECUTING AN OMNIBUS PROXY

The Commission proposed for comment amendments to extend from three to five business days the time period in which a bank is to execute and provide notice of the execution of an omnibus proxy to respondent banks, and other technical and clarifying changes to the shareholder communications rules. INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

RESIDENTIAL RESOURCES, INC.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until April 17 to request a hearing on an application filed by Residential Resources, Inc. and James C. Marshall (on behalf of certain affiliates) for an order exempting Residential and the affiliates from all provisions of the Investment Company Act in connection with the issuance and sale of mortgage-backed securities and equity interests. E. F. HUTTON MORTGAGE CAPITAL INC.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until April 17 to request a hearing on an application filed by E.F. Hutton Mortgage Capital Inc. (Depositor), subsidiary of The E. F. Hutton Group Inc., and certain trusts created by the Depositor (Trusts), requesting an order conditionally exempting Applicants from all provisions of the Investment Company Act in connection with the issuance by the Depositor and the Trusts of mortgage-backed securities and the sale of beneficial interests in the Depositor and the Trusts. An order has been issued exempting The Life Insurance Company of Virginia, Life of Virginia Separate Account II, and Life of Virginia Security Sales, Ltd. from the provisions of Sections 2(a)(32), 22(c), 26(a)(2), 27(c)(1), 27(c)(2), and 27(d) of the Investment Company Act and Rules 6e-3(T)(b)(12), 6e-3(T)(b)(13), and 22c-1 to permit a contingent deferred administration charge for expenses incurred in connection with the issuance of flexible premium variable life insurance contracts to be deducted from the amount otherwise payable upon surrender or lapse of the contract prior to the tenth contract year. HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

ALLEGHENY POWER SYSTEM, INC.

An order has been issued authorizing Allegheny Power System, Inc. (APS), a registered holding company, to issue up to three million shares of its common stock, \$2.50 par value, under its Dividend Reinvestment and Stock Purchase Plan and its Employee Stock Ownership and Savings Plan. (Rel. 35-24344 - March 17)

A supplemental order has been issued releasing jurisdiction previously reserved regarding West Penn Power Company in a prior Commission order [Rel. 35-23894, November 6, 1985], which authorized the issuance of guarantees concerning workers' compensation liabilities by APS on behalf of West Penn and other APS subsidiaries. (Rel. 35-24345 - March 17)

CENTRAL AND SOUTH WEST CORPORATION

An order has been issued authorizing Central and South West Corporation (CSW), a registered holding company, to amend its Restated Certificate of Incorporation, subject to shareholder approval, to provide for the limitation of personal liability of CSW directors and to seek the ratification of certain indemnification agreements between CSW and its directors and certain of its officers. The proposed amendments result from recent changes in the Delaware General Corporation Law. An order was issued under the Public Utility Holding Company Act of 1935 on February 19, 1987 [Rel. 35-24320] authorizing the solicitation of proxies. (Rel. 34-24346 - March 17)

The Chicago Board Options Exchange filed a proposed rule change under Rule 19b-4 (SR-CBOE-87-3) to make the index option escrow receipt pilot program permanent. Publication of the proposal is expected to be made in the Federal Register during the week of March 23. (Rel. 34-24253)
