U.S. SECURITIES AND
EXCHANGE COMMISSION

ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

PROCEEDINGS ORDERED AGAINST ALLIED STORES CORPORATION AND GEORGE C. KERN, JR.

The Commission today ordered public administrative proceedings under Section 15(c)(4) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 against Allied Stores Corporation and George C. Kern, Jr., counsel to and a director of Allied, to determine whether Allied failed to comply with Section 14(d)(4) of the Exchange Act and Rule 14d-9 and whether Kern was a cause of Allied's failures to comply.

The Division of Enforcement alleges that Allied failed to amend promptly, and Kern was a cause of Allied's failures to amend promptly, a Schedule 14D-9 filed by Allied with the Commission to disclose negotiations and agreements between Allied and a third party in response to a hostile tender offer, and a resolution of Allied's Board of Directors relating to an agreement between Allied and a third party. CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

WALTER WILOWATYJ ENJOINED

The Philadelphia Regional Office announced that on June 10 Judge J. Frederick Motz, U.S. District Court for the District of Maryland, enjoined Walter Wilowatyj from future violations of the antifraud, periodic reporting, and Foreign Corrupt Practices Act provisions of the securities laws. Wilowatyj consented to the permanent injunction without admitting or denying the allegations in the Commission's complaint.

The April 9 complaint alleged that Wilowatyj and two other defendants were involved in a scheme at Psych Systems, Inc. (PSI) to improperly recognize and report revenue in 1983. As a result, PSI's revenue was overstated by \$1,060,000 for the 1983 fiscal year. The complaint further alleged that Wilowatyj and the other defendants misled Alexander Grant & Co. during its audit of PSI. The Commission's action is continuing against the remaining defendants. (SEC v. Jerald Moskowitz, et al., DMD, Civil Action No. 87-862). (LR-11472)

HENDRIX R. BULL ENJOINED

The Los Angeles Regional Office announced that on June 11 the U.S. District Court for the Central District of California entered an Order of Permanent Injunction and Other Equitable Relief against Hendrix R. Bull, enjoining him from future violations of the antifraud provisions of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. Bull, without admitting or denying the allegations of the complaint, except for jurisdiction, consented to the Order and, under its terms, agreed to disgorge \$13,328.24 in losses avoided and to pay a civil penalty, under the Insider Trading Sanctions Act of 1984, in the amount of \$13,328.24.

The April 7 complaint alleged that Bull, formerly a director of Berry Industries Corporation, sold 22,220 shares of Berry common stock while in possession of material nonpublic information concerning Berry's impending filing for protection under Chapter 11 of the U.S. Bankruptcy Code. (SEC v. Hendrix R. Bull, Civil Action No. 87-02176, JSL, CDCA). (LR-11473)

IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

A proposed rule change filed by the Pacific Securities Depository Trust Company has become effective under Section 19(b) (3)(A) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. The proposed rule change (SR-PSDTC-87-5) waives fees for automatic journaling of accounts as long as the journaling of accounts is done in accordance with PSDTC's timetable. The proposed rule change is to help ensure a smooth transition of accounts to the participants' account at another depository. (Rel. 34-24638)

Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
