OPEN MEETING - THURSDAY, AUGUST 6, 1987 - 10:00 a.m.

The subject matter of the August 6 open meeting will be:

- (1) Consideration of whether to issue final rules amending Regulation S-K, Form 20-F, and the codification of Financial Reporting Policies governing the disclosure of the effects of inflation and other changes in prices. These amendments would delete references to Statement of Financial Accounting Standard (SFAS) No. 33, which was superseded by SFAS No. 89. These rule amendments do not affect the current requirements in Item 303 or Regulation S-K for registrants to include, where material, a discussion in Management's Discussion and Analysis of the impact of inflation and other changes in prices on their financial statements. - (2) Consideration of whether to propose for public comment amendments to Form N-1A, the registration form for open-end management investment companies, under the Investment Company Act of 1940 and the Securities Act of 1933 and publish related revisions to the staff guidelines for Form N-1A. The amendments would require mutual funds to consolidate all expense-related information in a table located near the front of the prospectus and expand the narrative disclosure requirements regarding Rule 12b-1 plans. - (3) Consideration of whether to propose changes in Forms 10-K and 10-Q that would require registrants, after reasonable inquiry, to provide information not filed in Form 3 and 4 reports required during the reporting period and identify any of their directors, officers, or ten percent security holders that have failed to file all of their Form 3 and 4 reports required during the reporting period in a timely manner. Copies of the Form 3 and 4 would be required to be sent to the registrant to aid its monitoring of such filings. In addition, the Commission will consider proposing to condition the safe harbor of Rule 144 upon the seller having filed all required Forms 3 and 4 in a timely manner during the 12 months preceding filing of Form 144 and any sales under the Rule. Form 144 would be amended to include a positive representation concerning the seller's compliance with Section 16(a) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

BARRY GRAISON DEFAULTS

In administrative proceedings ordered under Sections 15(b) and 19(h) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, the Commission issued Findings and Order Imposing Remedial Sanctions by Default against Barry Graison. Graison failed to answer the Order for Public Proceedings and, therefore, was in default.

On the basis of the Order for Public Proceedings, the Commission found that on June 4, 1985, Graison was convicted, after a jury trial, of conspiracy to defraud the United States (one count), and making, uttering, and possessing a forged government security (one count). The Commission also found that he committed the criminal acts which formed the basis of his convictions while employed as a registered representative of a registered broker-dealer.

The Commission ordered that Graison be barred from association with any broker, dealer, investment company, investment adviser, or municipal securities dealer. (Rel. 34-24713)
