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## TRADING SUSPENSIONS

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### TRADING SUSPENDED IN SECURITIES OF AMERICAN ASSURANCE UNDERWRITERS GROUP, INC.

The Commission announced the single ten-day suspension of over-the-counter trading in the securities of American Assurance Underwriters Group, Inc. (American Assurance), a business entity with offices located at Deerfield Beach, Florida, for the period beginning at 10:00 a.m. (EDT) on August 24, 1987, and terminating at 10:00 a.m. (EDT) on September 3, 1987. The Commission suspended trading in the securities of American Assurance because of the lack of adequate current financial information concerning such securities, and in view of questions that have been raised about the adequacy and accuracy of publicly disseminated information concerning, among other things, American Assurance's financial condition, securities transactions, and other matters. ### TRADING SUSPENDED IN SECURITIES OF INTERNATIONAL COMMUNICATIONS, INC.

The Commission announced the single ten-day suspension of over-the-counter trading in the securities of International Communications, Inc. (ICOM), a Nevada corporation, for the period beginning at 10:00 a.m. (EDT) on August 24, 1987, and terminating at 10:00 a.m. (EDT) on September 3, 1987. The Commission suspended trading in the securities of ICOM because of the lack of current financial statements and in view of questions that have been raised about the adequacy and accuracy of publicly disseminated information concerning the nature of ICOM's assets and its acquisitions of other businesses. 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## ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

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### JOHN G. RINALDO BARRED

Administrative Law Judge David J. Markun issued an initial decision barring John G. Rinaldo from association with an investment adviser.

The bar is based upon findings that Rinaldo was convicted in May 1985 in the U.S. District Court for the Central Division of California upon his plea of guilty to a charge of mail fraud, for which he received a three-year prison sentence, and upon related findings that from April 1979 to February 1983 he wilfully violated various antifraud and reporting provisions of the Investment Advisers Act of 1940, the Securities Act of 1933, and the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 through a fraudulent scheme that included Ponzi scheme characteristics and resulted in bankruptcy proceedings and losses to thousands of investors in IRA and Keough retirement plans.

The initial decision is subject to review by the Commission on its own motion or on petition of a party.

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## CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

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### RECEIVER APPOINTED OVER PERSONAL ASSETS OF QUILLIN PORTER AND HIS BUSINESS VENTURES

The Fort Worth Regional Office announced that on August 11 in the U.S. District Court for the Western District of Arkansas, after a hearing, Judge H. Franklin Waters issued Orders appointing Receivers over the personal assets of Quillin Porter and over Securities Savings Trust (SST), CPM Financial, Ltd., and Import Services, Inc., each controlled by Porter.

The First Amended Complaint filed by the Commission on August 4 alleges that Porter sold more than \$5 million of stock in Equity Investors of Arkansas, Inc. (EIA), an unregistered investment company, to over 250 investors in at least 20 states. Porter represented to purchasers of the stock that all proceeds from the sale would be invested in the stock market. In fact, only about \$1.2 million was actually invested in the market, with a total net loss on trades exceeding \$500,000. Nevertheless, in an apparent "ponzi" scheme, substantial dividends were continually paid to shareholders. The majority of the remaining funds were paid by Porter to himself, associates, family, friends, and to business entities controlled by them including SST, CPM, and Import Services. (SEC v.
