COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

TOP APPOINTMENTS MADE FOR HOUSTON BRANCH OFFICE

T. Christopher Browne, Fort Worth Regional Administrator, announced the appointments of Joseph C. Matta as Assistant Administrator and head of the Commission's 13-person enforcement office in Houston, Texas, and Joy M. Boddie as the office's Branch Chief, succeeding Matta in that position. Both appointments were effective late September.

Mr. Matta is a 1979 graduate of the University of Houston and a 1982 graduate of the Georgetown University Law Center. After being admitted to the Texas Bar in 1982, he joined the Fort Worth Regional Office as a staff attorney, transferring to the Houston Branch Office in late 1984. In April 1986, Mr. Matta was promoted to Branch Chief.

Ms. Boddie is a 1966 graduate of Clark University in Worcester, Massachusetts and a 1978 graduate of the University of Texas Law School in Austin, Texas. After being admitted to the Texas Bar, she joined the staff of the Houston Branch Office in December 1979.

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

JOHN HANCOCK MUTUAL LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY

An order has been issued exempting John Hancock Mutual Life Insurance Company and John Hancock Variable Annuity Account V from Sections 26(a)(2)(C) and 27(c)(2) of the Investment Company Act to permit the deduction of mortality and expense risk charges and a deferred sales charge equal to one percent of certain purchase payments in connection with the issuance of individual combination fixed/variable annuity contracts. ANCHOR NATIONAL LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY

An order has been issued approving the substitution of shares of Anchor Pathway Fund for shares of the American Pathway Fund held by American Pathway II - Separate Account of Anchor National Life Insurance Company. (Rel. IC-16099 - Oct. 30)

PRUDENTIAL-BACHE FINANCIAL ASSET FUNDING CORP.

An order has been issued exempting Prudential-Bache Financial Asset Funding Corp. and certain trusts from all provisions of the Investment Company Act in connection with the issuance of collateralized mortgage obligations securities and equity interests in such trusts, subject to conditions. ARCADIA BIDCO CORPORATION

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until November 19 to request a hearing on an application filed by Arcadia BIDCO Corporation, a Michigan business and industrial development corporation, for an order exempting it from all provisions of the Investment Company Act. HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

ALABAMA POWER COMPANY

A supplemental order has been issued releasing jurisdiction over the terms and conditions of the issuance and sale of up to \$200 million of first mortgage bonds, pursuant to an exception from competitive bidding, by Alabama Power Company, subsidiary of The Southern Company. Jurisdiction continues to be reserved over the terms

and conditions of the issuance and sale of up to \$100 million of preferred stock, the issuance and sale of an additional \$10 million of preferred stock, the issuance and sale of \$325 million of additional bonds, and the financing of pollution control facilities in an amount of up to \$125 million, pending completion of the record. SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission granted accelerated approval to a proposed rule change filed by the National Association of Securities Dealers, Inc. (SR-NASD-87-51) to extend the pilot program for the NASDAQ Workstation Service from November 1 through November 30, 1987. (Rel. 34-25083)

NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Municipal Securities Rulemaking Board filed a proposed rule change under Rule 19b-4 (SR-MSRB-87-13) amending its Rule G-32. The proposed rule change would provide an objective definition of "underwriting period" for sold underwritings for purposes of the Rule G-32 requirement that, during the underwriting period, official statements for new issues be delivered to customers no later than settlement. Publication of the proposal is expected to be made in the Federal Register during the week of November 2. (Rel. 34-25084)
