### OFFICE OF THE CHIEF ACCOUNTANT SELECTS THREE PROFESSIONAL ACCOUNTING FELLOWS

The Commission's Office of the Chief Accountant recently selected Eric W. Casey, Pascal Desroches, and Paul R. Kepple to serve as Professional Accounting Fellows for two-year terms beginning in June 1998. Currently, Mr. Casey and Mr. Desroches are Senior Managers in KPMG Peat Marwick LLP's Department of Professional Practice in New York, and Mr. Kepple is a Senior Manager in the national office of Price Waterhouse LLP in Stamford, Connecticut. Messrs. Casey, Desroches, and Kepple will join the current Professional Accounting Fellows -- Mr. Jeffrey N. Jones, Mr. D.J. Gannon, and Mr. Robert Uhl. They will replace outgoing Professional Accounting Fellows Ms. Donna L. Coallier, Mr. Armando Pimentel, and Mr. Cody L. Smith.

At the Commission, the newly selected Professional Accounting Fellows will work with the Chief Accountant and will be involved in the study and development of rule proposals under the federal securities laws, liaison with the professional accounting and auditing standards-setting bodies, and consultation with registrants on accounting and reporting matters. According to Ms. Jane B. Adams, Deputy Chief Accountant, "The Professional Accounting Fellowship Program, which began in 1972, has been a tremendous success. The Fellows are outstanding accountants who bring to the Commission a fresh perspective and foster better communications between the Commission and the private sector." (Press Rel. 98-45)

## INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

### CYPRESSTREE ASSET MANAGEMENT CORPORATION, INC. AND NORTH AMERICAN FUNDS

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until May 29 to request a hearing on an application filed by CypressTree Asset Management Corporation, Inc. and North American Funds for an order pursuant to Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act that would exempt applicants from Section 15(a) of the Act and Rule 18f-2 under the Act and from certain disclosure requirements of the Act. The

order would permit applicants to hire sub-advisers and materially amend sub-advisory agreements without shareholder approval, and grant relief from certain disclosure requirements. (Rel. IC-23169 - May 4)

## HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

### AMERICAN ELECTRIC POWER COMPANY, INC., ET AL.

An order has been issued on a proposal by American Electric Power Company, Inc. (AEP), a registered holding company, and eight electric utility subsidiary companies, Appalachian Power Company (Appalachian), Columbus Southern Power Company (Columbus), Indiana Michigan Power Company (Indiana), Kentucky Power Company (Kentucky), Ohio Power Company (Ohio), AEP Generating Company (Generating), Kingsport Power Company (Kingsport), and Wheeling Power Company (Wheeling). AEP, Appalachian, Columbus, Indiana, Kentucky and Ohio have been authorized to incur short-term debt through the issuance and sale of short-term notes to banks and commercial paper to dealers. Generating, Kingsport and Wheeling have been authorized to increase the amount of short-term debt they may incur through the issuance and sale of short-term notes to banks. The aggregate outstanding principal amount of short-term debt would not exceed \$2.135 billion at any one time. In addition, AEP has been authorized to guarantee up to \$40 million in short-term debt of American Electric Power Service Corporation, a nonutility subsidiary. (Rel. 35-26867)
