ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS

SEC V. EDWARD J. PARADIS, JR., AND WALTER R. SNYDER, JR.

The Commission announced that on April 30, 1998, the Honorable Nancy Gertner, U.S. District Judge for the District of Massachusetts, entered a Preliminary Injunction and Order Continuing Asset Freeze and Other Relief preliminarily enjoining Edward J. Paradis, Jr., of Sturbridge, Massachusetts, and Walter R. Snyder, Jr., of Southbridge, Massachusetts, from continuing a fraudulent investment scheme in violation of the federal securities laws. The Order also continues a freeze of assets of Paradis and Snyder originally entered by the Court on April 13, 1998, and grants other relief. The Court entered the Order upon a motion by the Commission. One of the defendants, Walter Snyder, consented to the relief.

The Commission's complaint in the action alleges that Paradis and Snyder obtained \$175,000 from an investor, promising him a return of over 300% in stock and cash within thirty days. They falsely told the investor that his money would be safely held in Snyder's attorney escrow account until completion of a "financing" transaction that would produce the 300% profit. Contrary to their promises to the investor, Paradis and Snyder began removing the investor's funds as soon as the funds arrived in Snyder's account and have misappropriated at least \$157,000 to date, using it for purposes such as paying Paradis' rent. Some of the investor funds were transferred to a Swiss bank account in Paradis' name. On April 13, the Court granted a temporary restraining order and asset freeze and ordered repatriation of funds diverted overseas.

In the April 30 Order, the Court ruled that the Commission had shown a likelihood that it would prove at trial that defendants had violated the antifraud provisions of the federal securities laws, Section 17(a) of the Securities Act of 1933 and Sections 10(b) and 15(a) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Rule 10b-5 thereunder. In its lawsuit, the Commission also seeks a permanent injunction, disgorgement of Paradis' and Snyder's ill-gotten gains and civil monetary penalties. For further information, please see LR-15706. INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

PAX WORLD FUND, INCORPORATED, ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until June 1, 1998, to request a hearing on an application filed by Pax World Fund, Incorporated, et al. under Section 12(d)(1)(J) of the Investment Company Act exempting applicants from Sections 12(d)(1)(A) and (B) of the Act, under Sections 6(c) and 17(b) of the Act exempting applicants from Section 17(a) of the Act, and under Section 17(d) of the Act and Rule 17d-1 under the Act permitting certain joint transactions. The requested order would permit certain registered open-end management investment companies to invest excess cash in an affiliated money market fund. (Rel. IC-23175 - May 7)

THE JPM ADVISOR FUNDS

An order has been issued under Section 8(f) of the Investment Company Act declaring that The JPM Advisor Funds has ceased to be an investment company. (Rel. IC-23176 - May 7)

LEHMAN BROTHERS INC.

An order has been issued on an application filed by Lehman Brothers Inc. (Lehman) under Section 12(d)(1)(J) of the Investment Company Act exempting the PIES trusts for which Lehman will serve as a principal underwriter (Trusts) from Section 12(d)(1) of the Act, under Section 6(c) of the Act exempting the Trusts from Section 14(a) of the Act, and under Section 17(b) of the Act exempting Lehman and the Trusts from Section 17(a) of the Act. The order would permit other registered investment companies, and companies excepted from the definition of investment company under Sections 3(c)(1) and (c)(7) of the Act, to own a greater percentage of the total outstanding voting stock (Securities) of the Trusts than that permitted by Section 12(d)(1) of the Act. The order would also exempt the Trusts from the initial net worth requirements of Section 14(a) of the Act and permit the Trusts to purchase U.S. government securities from Lehman at the time of a Trust's initial issuance of Securities. NATIONSBANC MONTGOMERY SECURITIES LLC

An order has been issued on an application filed by NationsBanc Montgomery Securities LLC (NationsBanc) under Section 12(d)(1)(J) of the Investment Company Act exempting Hybrid Income Trust Securities trusts for which NationsBanc will serve as a principal underwriter (Trusts) from Section 12(d)(1) of the Act, under Section 6(c) of the Act exempting the Trusts from Section 14(a) of the Act, and under Section 17(b) of the Act exempting NationsBanc and the Trusts from

Section 17(a) of the Act. The order would permit other registered investment companies and companies excepted from the definition of investment company under Sections 3(c)(1) and (c)(7) of the Act to own a greater percentage of the total outstanding voting stock (Securities) of the Trusts than that permitted by Section 12(d)(1) of the Act. The order would also exempt the Trusts from the initial net worth requirements of Section 14(a) of the Act, and permit the Trusts to purchase U.S. government securities from NationsBanc at the time of a Trust's initial issuance of Securities. SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission approved a proposed rule change (SR-Phlx-98-03) filed by the Philadelphia Stock Exchange which replaces the text of Phlx Rule 124, "Disputes," with new text stating, among other things, that floor officials may resolve trading disputes occurring on and relating to the trading floor if the dispute is not settled by agreement between the members interested or by vote of the members knowing of the transaction. Publication of the approval order is expected to be made in the Federal Register during the week of May 11. (Rel. 34-39975)
