RULES AND RELATED MATTERS

REFORM OF COMMISSION RULES UNDER SECURITIES ACT OF 1933

The Commission has issued a release soliciting public comment on a package of rule proposals and amendments to modernize the structure of the regulatory system for offerings under the Securities Act of 1933. REGULATION OF TAKEOVERS AND SECURITY HOLDER COMMUNICATIONS

The Commission has issued a release soliciting public comment on a package of rule proposals to update and simplify the regulations applicable to tender offers, mergers, acquisitions, and similar extraordinary transactions (business combinations). The proposals would permit significantly more communications with security holders and the markets before the filing of a registration statement involving a business combination; a tender offer statement; or any proxy statement, whether or not involving a business combination. The proposals also are designed to put cash tender offers and exchange offers on a more equal regulatory footing, more closely align merger and tender offer requirements, harmonize and consolidate the business combination disclosure requirements, and update the tender offer rules. ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS

COMMISSION REMANDS NASD ACTION AGAINST WARREN SCHREIBER

The Commission has remanded the appeal of Warren R. Schreiber from the disciplinary action of the National Association of Securities Dealers, Inc. (NASD). The NASD charged Schreiber with, among other things, distributing unregistered securities of Merlin Baines, Inc.,

market manipulation, and insider trading. The NASD censured Schreiber, barred him from association with any member firm, and fined him \$100,000.

In its decision, the NASD's Market Surveillance Committee (MSC) made generalized findings as to the credibility of a key witness and Schreiber. The MSC's decision did not, however, reflect whether the fact-finder considered substantial evidence that contradicted these findings.

The Commission cannot complete its review function in this matter until the NASD has provided the Commission with clarification of the basis of its credibility determinations. The Commission's remand will permit the NASD to discuss explicitly the record evidence bearing on witness credibility. In ordering the remand the Commission expressed no view on the outcome of this proceeding. (Release No. 34-40629)

COMMISSION SUSTAINS NEW YORK STOCK EXCHANGE DISCIPLINARY ACTION AGAINST CATHY KIRKPATRICK

The Commission has sustained New York Stock Exchange (NYSE) disciplinary action against Cathy Jean Krause Kirkpatrick. The NYSE found that Kirkpatrick made unauthorized trades and misappropriated funds in a customer's account, signed the customer's name to new account form documents without the customer's knowledge or authorization, and provided the customer with false financial information. The NYSE censured Kirkpatrick and barred her from membership, allied membership, and approved person status, and from employment or association in any capacity with any member or member organization.

In sustaining the NYSE's findings of violations, the Commission rejected Kirkpatrick's principal argument that the customer gave her complete discretionary authority over the account. The Commission determined that Kirkpatrick's handling of the account, including her withdrawal of 80% of the funds within the first week that the account was opened, was inconsistent with the customer's directives. Based on Kirkpatrick's misconduct, which spanned a two-year period of time, the Commission concluded that the sanctions assessed against her were neither excessive nor oppressive. (Rel. 34-40630)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

THE WRIGHT MANAGED BLUE CHIP SERIES TRUST, ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until November 27 to request a hearing on an application filed by The Wright Managed Blue Chip Series Trust (Trust) and Wright Investors' Service, Inc. (Wright). Applicants request an order pursuant to Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act exempting them from Sections 9(a), 13(a),

15(a) and 15(b) of the Act and Rules 6e-2(b)(15) and 6e-3(T)(b)(15) thereunder. The order would permit shares of the Trust and any similar investment companies for which Wright or any of its affiliates may in the future serve as investment adviser, administrator, principal underwriter or sponsor to be sold to and held by separate accounts funding variable annuity and variable life insurance contracts issued by both affiliated and unaffiliated life insurance companies; and qualified pension and retirement plans outside of the separate account context. JOHN HANCOCK BOND TRUST, ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until November 27 to request a hearing on an application filed by certain open-end management investment companies organized by John Hancock Mutual Life Insurance Company (John Hancock) or an affiliate (Funds); John Hancock Funds, Inc. (JHFI); John Hancock Variable Life Insurance Company (JHVLICO); and John Hancock. Applicants seek an order pursuant to Section 11(a) of the Investment Company Act approving the terms of offers of exchange by the Funds and JHFI to certain holders of variable annuity contracts issued by Variable Annuity Accounts U and V of John Hancock and Variable Annuity Account I of JHVLICO. MACC PRIVATE EQUITIES INC., ET AL.

An order has been issued on an application filed by MACC Private Equities Inc., et al. under Sections 6(c) and 57(i) of the Investment Company Act, and under Rule 17d-1 under the Act permitting certain joint transactions otherwise prohibited by Section 57(a)(4) of the Act. HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

INTERSTATE ENERGY CORPORATION, ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until November 27 to request a hearing on a proposal by Interstate Energy Corporation (IEC), a registered holding company, its wholly owned subsidiary, Alliant Industries, Inc. (Alliant) and certain other subsidiaries. IEC and Alliant propose through December 31, 2000, to form and fund a utility money pool and a nonutility money pool in aggregate amounts not to exceed \$450 million and \$600 million respectively, through the issuance and sale of commercial paper and bank borrowings. In addition, IEC proposes through December 31, 2000, to finance the acquisition of foreign utility companies and exempt wholesale generators through the issuance and sale of commercial paper and bank borrowings in an amount not to exceed \$300 million, and issue guarantees in an aggregate principal amount not to exceed \$600 million. COLUMBIA ENERGY GROUP, ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until November 27 to request a hearing on a proposal by Columbia Energy Group (Columbia), a registered holding company, and its wholly owned subsidiary company, Columbia Electric Corporation (Columbia Electric). Columbia proposes to acquire indirectly, through Columbia Electric, a 50% interest in a cogeneration facility (Project Gregory) to be constructed in Gregory, Texas and to issue guarantees in an aggregate amount not to exceed \$200 million.
