DECISIONS IN ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

DECISION BARRING JAMES A. NOON, III FINAL

The decision of an administrative law judge barring James A. Noon, III, of <u>Warwick Rhode Island</u>, from association with any broker-dealer has become final. After one year, Noon, who was vice president of a broker-dealer firm, may apply to the Commission to become so associated in a non-proprietary capacity, upon a proper showing of adequate supervision.

According to the decision, Noon violated antifraud provisions of the securities acts by participating in a fraudulent scheme involving a January 1971 offering of securities of Develco, Inc. through his firm as underwriter. It was also found that Noon aided and abetted violations of prospectus-delivery and credit extension provisions. (Rel. 34-11262)

W. A. FOX & CO., WILLIAM A. FOX, JR. SUSPENDED

The Commission has suspended the broker-dealer registration of W. A. Fox & Co., of Pompton Lakes, New Jersey, for 10 days. It also suspended the firm's president, William A. Fox, Jr., from association with any broker or dealer for 10 days. The suspensions begin March 3.

The sanctions were based on findings that the firm, aided and abetted by Fox, failed to file reports of its financial condition for 1971 and 1972.

Without admitting or denying the charges, the firm and Fox consented to the above findings and sanctions. (Rel. 34-11263)

COURT ENFORCEMENT ACTIONS

WILLIAM S. TYSON ENJOINED

The Washington Regional Office announced that on February 21 the federal court in Washington, D.C. entered an order permanently enjoining William S. Tyson of Washington, D.C. from violations of the registration and antifraud provisions of the securities laws in the offer and sale of limited and general partnership interests. The defendant consented to the entry of the order without admitting or denying the allegations of the Commission's complaint. (SEC v. Carib Investments, Inc., et al., U.S.D.C., D.C., Civ. Action No. 75-0198). (LR-6764)

COMPLAINT NAMES HERSHBERGER ENTERPRISES, INC., OTHERS

The Fort Worth and Seattle Regional Offices announced the filing on February 25 of a civil injunctive action in Federal District Court in Wichita, Kansas against Hershberger Enterprises, Inc., formerly Hershberger Explorations, Inc., and James W. Hershberger, both of Wichita, Loren E. Lake of Goddard, Kansas, and Cosse International Securities, Inc. and Charles B. Cosse, both of Seattle, Washington.

The complaint alleged that Hershberger Enterprises, Inc., Hershberger, Lake, Cosse International Securities, Inc. and Cosse violated the securities registration provisions of the securities laws and that all of the defendants except Lake violated the antifraud provisions of the securities laws in the offer and sale of fractional undivided working interests in Kansas Oil and gas leases issued by Hershberger Enterprises, Inc. Hershberger Enterprises, Inc. filed a voluntary petition in bankruptcy in Federal Court at Wichita on November 15, 1974. (SEC v. Hershberger Enterprises, Inc., District of Kansas). (LR-6765)

An order has been issued on an application of The Municipal Income Fund, First Insured Discount Series and Subsequent Series (Funds), registered unit investment trusts, and Merrill Lynch, Pierce, Fenner & Smith, Incorporated, sponsor of the Funds (Sponsor) permitting (1) the Funds, unmanaged unit investment trusts, and the Sponsor to make a public offering of Units of the Funds which represent undivided interests in an underlying portfolio of deposited and identified bonds, without having to sell \$100,000 worth of such Units to 25 or fewer investors, (2) the Funds to make monthly distributions of capital gains, the production of which will be substantially independent of action by the Sponsor and the Trustee, instead of being required to hold such gains in cash for annual distribution, and (3) the Sponsor to engage in secondary market operations involving repurchases and resales of the redeemable Units at prices determined through an evaluation made on the last business day of the week prior to the week in which such secondary market transactions occur. PIONEER FUND

An order has been issued on an application of Pioneer Fund, Inc., a mutual fund, permitting Pioneer Fund to issue shares of its redeemable common stock without sales charges in exchange for substantially all of the assets of Munoz Corporation, a personal holding company which maintains a diversified portfolio of securities. GEORGIA POWER COMPANY

A supplemental order has been issued correcting an order which authorized the issuance and sale of notes to banks by Georgia Power Company, subsidiary of The Southern Company. (Rel. 35-18831 - Feb. 27)

AMERICAN NATURAL GAS COMPANY

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until March 25 to request a hearing on a proposal of American Natural Gas Company to spin-off the stock of Wisconsin Gas Company, a wholly-owned gas utility subsidiary. American Natural further requests that an order issue exempting it under Section 3(a)(1) from the registration requirements of the Act. In connection with the foregoing proposals, an order has issued authorizing American Natural to solicit the proxies of its shareholders. (Rel. 35-18832 - Feb. 28)
