#### DONALD C. LANGE, OTHERS SENTENCED

## LIBRARY

The Denver Regional Office announced that on March 3 the Honorable Malcolm M. Lucus, U.S. District Judge at Los Angeles sentenced: Donald C. Lange, formerly of Marina del Rey, California and Casper, Wyoming to three years imprisonment; Harold Schwartz of Los Angeles and James J. Journigan of Scottsdale, Arizona to six months imprisonment and two years probation; and Martin L. Sanchez of Casper, Wyoming was placed on two years probation and fined \$1000. On February 3, 1975 Lange, Schwartz, Journigan and Sanchez were convicted on charges in a multi-count indictment alleging securities fraud, mail fraud, and securities non-registration. (U.S. v. Donald C. Lange, Harold Schwartz, James J. Journigan and Martin L. Sanchez, C.D. Cal.). (LR-6783)

#### SMITH BROS. & CO. DISMISSED

The Chicago Regional Office announced that on March 12 the Federal Court in Chicago, Illinois, dismissed the Commission's complaint for injunction against Smith Bros. & Co. The action was taken upon the Commission's own motion because of the dissolution of the firm, a partnership, by operation of law, with its affairs completely wound up, including satisfaction of all customers' claims for cash and securities.
