# **DECISIONS IN ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS**

WISCO HARDWARE COMPANY OFFER OF SETTLEMENT ACCEPTED

The Commission has accepted an offer of settlement submitted by Wisco Hardware Company of Madison, Wisconsin, relating to Wisco's application for exemption from registration of its common stock. Wisco, a dealer-owned wholesaler of general hardware and building materials, has agreed to register its stock on August 1 and thereafter to comply with the reporting and proxy provisions of the Securities Exchange Act. In addition, Wisco will cause appropriate ownership reports to be filed, provide audited financial statements for its last five fiscal years and disclosure of all events of the last five years which would have been reported on Form 8-K. The offer also provides that if Wisco is dissolved prior to August 1, 1975, no registration will be required. (Rel. 34-11533)

RALPH T. IANNELLI AND HOWARD FROST CITED; IANNELLI BARRED; FROST BARRED AS SUPERVISOR

The Commission has instituted broker-dealer proceedings against Ralph T. Iannelli, of South Orange, New Jersey, and Howard Frost, of West Orange, New Jersey. Both were associated with a registered broker-dealer of New York City, Iannelli as a salesman and Frost as its president. At the same time, the Commission barred Iannelli from further association with any broker, dealer, investment company or investment adviser. It also suspended Frost from any such association for 15 days beginning August 4, 1975 and barred him from such association in a supervisory capacity. He may, however, after one year, apply to the Commission to become reassociated in a supervisory capacity.

The sanctions were based on a finding that the United States Court in Manhattan had, on their consent, permanently enjoined both Iannelli and Frost from violating the antifraud provisions of the securities laws.

Iannelli and Frost consented to the finding and to the sanctions solely to settle this matter and without admitting or denying the basis for the sanctions. (Rel. 34-11527)

## **COURT ENFORCEMENT ACTIONS**

ROWLAND, INCORPORATED, OTHERS ENJOINED

The SEC announced that on July 14 U.S. District Judge Howard Corcoran of the U.S. District Court for the District of Columbia, entered a final judgment of permanent injunction against Rowland, Incorporated, a Connecticut corporation with its principal place of business at Kensington, Connecticut, Donald Alan Morrison, Norbert Schimmel, Hermes Plastics, Inc., Hermes Plastics Midwest, Inc., and Hermes Plastics Dallas, Incorporated enjoining the defendants from violations of the antifraud, reporting, and proxy provisions of the securities laws. The defendants consented to the entry of the judgment without admitting or denying the allegations contained in the Commission's complaint, which charged non-disclosure of certain transactions in Rowland's stock, the purposes of which were to prevent certain persons considered undesirable by Morrison and others from obtaining control of Rowland. Further, the Commission's complaint charged non-disclosure of certain dealings between Rowland and the Hermes companies. (SEC v. Rowland, Incorporated, et al., D.D.C. Civil Action No. 75-1122).
