COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

FOIA APPEAL OF LOUIS P. GOLDSTEIN DENIED

The General Counsel sent a letter to Louis P. Goldstein, affirming in part and reversing in part the decision of the Commission's Freedom of Information Officer to withhold portions of the FOCUS Reports of three brokerage firms. The General Counsel determined that, with one exception, FOIA Exemptions 4 and 8 protected the contents of the FOCUS Reports. The General Counsel reversed the FOIA Officer's decision as it pertained to the brokerage firms' Statements of Financial Condition contained in their annual FOCUS Reports. These Statements are expressly made public by Commission Rule 17a-5(e)(3). (Rel. FOIA-116)

RULES AND RELATED MATTERS

COMMISSION ISSUES RELEASE ADOPTING RULE 15c2-12

The Commission has issued a release adopting Rule 15c2-12, which will become effective on January 1, 1990. The rule requires underwriters of municipal securities to obtain, review, and disseminate disclosure documents concerning the municipal securities they underwrite. The release also modifies the list of factors included in the Commission's interpretation of the responsibilities of underwriters of municipal securities that was published in Securities Exchange Act Release No. 26100 (Sept. 22, 1988), 53 FR 37778 (1988). The Commission also delegated authority to the Division of Market Regulation to grant exemptions from Rule 15c2-12. (Rel. 34-26985; 34-26986)

COMMISSION ADOPTS RULES 61-68

The Commission has adopted Rules 61-68 as new Subpart C of the Rules of Practice. The rules implement the bounty program of Section 21A(e) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, which was added by the Insider Trading and Securities Fraud Enforcement Act of 1988. Section 21A(e) authorizes the Commission, in its sole discretion, to award bounties to persons who provide information that leads to the imposition of a civil penalty in insider trading litigation. The rules set forth the requirements for bounty applications, including: the information that must be provided in an application; the deadline for filing the application; and the procedures by which an informant may temporarily preserve his or her anonymity. INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

PREMIER ACCEPTANCE CORPORATION AND PIPER JAFFRAY INCORPORATED

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until July 19 to request a hearing on an application filed by Premier Acceptance Corporation and Piper Jaffray Incorporated (Applicants) requesting an order under Section 6(c) exempting Applicants from all provisions of the Investment Company Act of 1940 to permit them to issue collateralized mortgage obligations and to sell residual interests in any excess cash flow on such obligations. USLIFE SEPARATE ACCOUNT I

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until July 24 to request a hearing on an application filed by USLIFE Separate Account I (Applicant) for an order under Section 8(f) of the Investment Company Act of 1940 declaring that the Applicant has ceased to be an investment company. HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

SOUTHWESTERN ELECTRIC POWER COMPANY

An order has been issued authorizing SOUTHWESTERN ELECTRIC POWER COMPANY (SWEPCO), a subsidiary of Central and South West Corporation, a registered holding company, to lease its railcars to nonassociated companies from time-to-time on a short term basis when they are not being used by SWEPCO. THE COLUMBIA GAS SYSTEM, INC.

A supplemental order has been issued authorizing COLUMBIA GAS SYSTEM, INC. (Columbia), a registered holding company, and its distribution subsidiaries, Commonwealth Gas Services, Inc. (COS) and Lynchburg Gas Company (Lynchburg), whereby Columbia will transfer all of the common shares of Lynchburg, \$5 par value, to COS in exchange for COS's common stock, \$50 par value, on a ten for one basis to effect a merger of Lynchburg into COS. LISTING, DELISTING AND UNLISTED TRADING ACTIONS

DELISTING GRANTED

An order has been issued granting the application of the American Stock Exchange to strike from listing and registration the common stock, no par value, of WESPERCORP. (Rel. 34-26979)

UNLISTED TRADING GRANTED

An order has been issued granting the application of the Midwest Stock Exchange for unlisted trading privileges in the common stock of fourteen issues which are listed and registered on one or more other national securities exchange and are reported in the consolidated transaction reporting system. SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE; IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission has noticed and approved, on an accelerated basis, a rule change submitted by the Chicago Board Options Exchange (SR-CBOE-89-12) to clarify existing rules for interest rate options contracts. Additionally, the Commission has noticed, as part of the proposed rule change, transaction fees for interest rate options. Such fees became effective pursuant to Section 19(b)(3) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. (Rel. 34-26958)

AMENDMENTS TO PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The New York Stock Exchange has filed amendments to a proposed rule change (SR-NYSE-88-19) under Rule 19b-4 relating to the Exchange's shareholder approval policy for domestic companies. Publication of the proposal is expected to be made in the Federal Register during the week of June 26. (Rel. 34-26959)

IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

On June 5, The Depository Trust Company filed a proposed rule change under Rule 19b-4 (SR-DTC-89-11) to establish fees for DTC's proposed Rush Withdrawal Transfer Service and provides the Commission with amended Participant Operating Procedures and Participant Terminal System Procedures. Publication of the proposal is expected to be made in the Federal Register during the week of June 19. (Rel. 34-26960)

Persons eligible to use the short form (Schedule 13G) may in lieu of filing a Schedule 13D file a Schedule 13G within 45 days after the end of the calendar year in which the person became subject to Section 13(d)(1). Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
