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## COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

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### REPORT OF FLORIDA PENNY STOCK TASK FORCE RELEASED

The Commission released a Report on the first year of activity of the Florida Penny Stock Task Force. The Commission, National Association of Securities Dealers, and State of Florida are working together to address the problems of fraudulent activities.

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## ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

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### NASD ACTION AGAINST HAMILTON BOHNER, INC., OTHERS AFFIRMED

The Commission affirmed disciplinary action taken by the NASD against Hamilton Bohner, Inc., of Englewood, Colorado, a former NASD member, John R. McKowen, its president, and John E. Sherman, its vice president. The NASD censured the firm, fined it \$15,000, and suspended it from membership for 30 days. McKowen was censured, fined \$25,000, and suspended from association with any member for one year. Sherman was censured, fined \$15,000, and suspended from any such association for 30 days. In addition, respondents were ordered, jointly and severally, to disgorge \$509,880 to the M.M. Parsons Trust.

The Commission found, as had the NASD, that respondents charged excessive compensation for selling securities for Trust, and that the firm and McKowen were responsible for failing to disclose on Trust's confirmations the capacity in which the firm was acting and the amount of compensation it was charging. In affirming the sanctions assessed by the NASD, the Commission observed that, in exacting payment for their services that was clearly excessive, respondents ignored their basic obligation of fair dealing. 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## CRIMINAL PROCEEDINGS

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### MARK S. BENSKIN PLEADS GUILTY

The Atlanta Regional Office and the U.S. Attorney's Office for the Western District of Tennessee announced that on September 5 Judge Julia S. Gibbons, Western District of Tennessee, Western Division, accepted a plea of guilty from Mark S. Benskin and Mark Benskin and Company, Inc. (MBC), both of Memphis, Tennessee, to all counts of a 50-count indictment. The indictment, filed on June 12, charged that Benskin, through MBC, operated as an unregistered broker-dealer and defrauded over 600 investors from 22 states of over \$3.8 million. It alleged that Benskin made numerous misrepresentations and omissions of material facts to his clients primarily concerning his misappropriation of their funds. (U.S. v. 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## INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

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### RNC CORPORATE CASH MANAGEMENT FUND, INC.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until October 2 to request a hearing on an application filed by RNC Corporate Cash Management Fund, Inc. for an order declaring that it has ceased to be an investment company. (Rel. IC-17132 - Sept. 8)

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## HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

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### NEW ENGLAND ELECTRIC SYSTEM

An order has been issued authorizing New England Electric System (NEES), a registered holding company, to issue and sell from time-to-time through July 31, 1991 up to 4,000,000 shares of its authorized but unissued common stock, par value \$1 per share, pursuant to an exception from the competitive bidding requirements of Rule 50 under subsection 50(a)(5) or, alternatively, at competitive bidding in accordance with the alternative procedures to Rule 50 authorized by the Statement of Policy dated September 2, 1982 [Rel. 35-22623]. Jurisdiction is reserved as to the fees, expenses, terms, and conditions associated with the sale of the common stock sold pursuant to an exception from competitive bidding. ### ALABAMA POWER COMPANY

An order has been issued authorizing a proposal by Alabama Power Company, subsidiary of The Southern Company, to acquire, pursuant to a court order in a bankruptcy proceeding, in excess of 5% of the voting securities of Simetco, Inc., a nonassociated company. (Rel. 35-24951 - Sept. 11)

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### NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The American Stock Exchange filed a proposed rule change under Rule 19b-4 (SR-Amex-89-16, Amendment No. 1) to modify the procedure by which last sale prices for components of the proposed Japan Index will be calculated. Publication of the proposal is expected to be made in the Federal Register during the week of September 18. (Rel. 34-27233)

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## TRUST INDENTURE ACT RELEASES

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### USAIR, INC.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until October 2 to request a hearing on an application by USAir, Inc., a Delaware corporation, under Section 310(b)(1) (ii) of the Trust Indenture Act of 1939. The application declares that the trusteeship of The Connecticut National Bank under 25 or more indentures all as more fully set forth in said application and in the Notice of Application and Opportunity for Hearing is not so likely to involve a material conflict of interest as to make it necessary in the public interest or for the protection of investors to disqualify the Bank from acting as trustee under each such indenture. Nine indentures are dated 1985 through 1987, and the securities outstanding under them are \$196,092,995 of Deferred Purchase Certificates and Loan Certificates. Fourteen indentures are dated January through July 1989, and the securities outstanding under them are \$311 million of Equipment Purchase Notes.
