COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

FOIA APPEAL OF JAMES P. MCCABE

The General Counsel sent a letter to James P. McCabe which (1) affirmed, in part, the Freedom of Information Act Officer's withholding, under Exemption 7(C), of documents obtained during SEC investigations agreeing that their disclosure could reasonably be expected to constitute an unwarranted invasion of personal privacy; (2) reversed the FOIA Officer's decision to withhold, and authorized release of some 212 pages and portions of 16 more, because they relate to matters specifically alleged and already made public by Commission Complaints filed in court; and (3) remanded to the FOIA Officer the remaining documents to determine whether release of financial information therein is likely to cause competitive harm (within the meaning of Exemption 4), whether any other exemptions apply, and whether documents of exempt and nonexempt information can be reasonably segregated, ordering release of reasonably segregable nonexempt portions. McCabe sought access to material relating to Dennis Levine and Bank Leu. The documents withheld consist primarily of records of the personal financial affairs of Robert M. Wilkis and Ira B. Sokolow. ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

VC MANAGEMENT (OF CONN) AND RICHARD F.F. NICHOLS SANCTIONED

The Commission accepted an Offer of Settlement to previously instituted administrative proceedings from VC Management (of Conn), Inc., a registered investment adviser in New York City, and its president, Richard F.F. Nichols.

The Commission made findings, which Respondents neither admitted nor denied, that they violated the antifraud provisions of the securities laws in the offer and sale of securities of the Greenfield Fund, a registered investment company advised by VC; that Respondents wilfully aided and abetted the Fund's violations of various of the Investment Company Act governing the composition of the Fund's Board of Directors, employees' securities transaction reports, fidelity bonds, timely share redemptions, segregation and marking of portfolio securities, depository arrangements, computation of net asset value, and books and records.

VC has been prohibited from advising investment companies for 18 months; it may continue to advise the Fund without fee for nine months. Nichols has been prohibited from acting as an officer or director of an investment company for 18 months, but may so serve the Fund if 60% of its directors are non-interested. Respondents have also been ordered to adopt improved compliance procedures to be recommended by a consultant. (Rel. IA-1210)

CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

CRIMINAL CONTEMPT CHARGES, ORDER OF CIVIL CONTEMPT FILED

The Chicago Regional Office and the U.S. Attorney announced that on November 3 a Criminal Contempt Application against William Keller and Christopher Greenberg was filed in the U.S. District Court for the Northern District of Illinois. The Application alleges that from about May to August 1989, Keller and Greenberg offered and sold the unregistered securities of Global Fax, Limited in violation of the Court's previously-issued orders. It further alleges that defendants made material misrepresentations to investors concerning the nature of Global Fax's business, returns, risks, and use of the proceeds.

On November 6, Judge James B. Moran entered an Order of Civil Contempt against Keller, Greenberg, and Global Investment Brokers, Limited. The Order requires defendants to disgorge the proceeds from the sale of Global Fax securities in the amount of \$110,000. (SEC v. Global Investment Brokers, Limited, et al., USDC NDIL, Civil Action No. 89 C 1946, filed March 9, 1989). (LR-12294)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

FIRST CHARTER LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY

An order has been issued exempting First Charter Life Insurance Company, First Charter Variable Annuity Account, and CNL, Inc. from Sections 26(a)(2) and 27(c)(2) of the Investment Company Act to permit the deduction of mortality and expense risk charges from the assets of the Variable Account. MORGAN KEEGAN DAILY CASH TRUST
