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## CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

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### PARTIAL SUMMARY JUDGMENT GRANTED AGAINST RICHARD "R.G." REYNOLDS AND R.G. REYNOLDS ENTERPRISES, INC.

The Los Angeles Regional Office announced that on November 27 partial summary judgment was granted in favor of the Commission against self-proclaimed investment adviser Richard "R.G." Reynolds (Reynolds) and his company, R.G. Reynolds Enterprises, Inc. (Enterprises), after a hearing before U.S. District Judge A. Andrew Hauk. The Court found that Reynolds and Enterprises violated the registration and antifraud provisions of the securities laws in the offer and sale of securities referred to as the "Loan Program/Managed Account" and the "Moreland Gold Program." These two offerings raised approximately \$5 million from about 400 investors. The Court also found that Reynolds committed fraud as an unregistered investment adviser and operated an unregistered investment company and that Reynolds and Enterprises acted as unregistered broker-dealers. Additionally, the Court found that Enterprises and Reynolds should be enjoined from further violations of the

securities laws, ordered to provide an accounting and ordered to disgorge funds raised from their securities offerings. The sole issue reserved for trial is a determination of the amount of disgorgement. The Denver Regional Office provided assistance in this case. (SEC v. R.G. Reynolds Enterprises, Inc., et al., CDCA Civil Action No. 88-01978 AAH (Kx)). (IR-12310)

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## HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

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### GEORGIA POWER COMPANY

A supplemental order has been issued authorizing Georgia Power Company, subsidiary of The Southern Company, to begin negotiating the terms and conditions of up to \$250 million aggregate principal amount of variable rate first mortgage bonds to be issued and sold from time to time, on or prior to December 31, 1989. Jurisdiction has been reserved over other matters proposed in the amended application-declaration pending completion of the record. (Rel. 35-24991 - Nov. 29)

Notices have been issued giving interested persons until December 18 to request a hearing on a proposal by: (1) Central and South West Corporation (CSW), a registered holding company, and its subsidiary, CSW Credit, Inc. (Credit), for Credit to change its debt to equity ratio from 80% debt and 20% equity to a requirement that the equity ratio be no less than 15%. In addition, CSW and Credit are seeking an extension of the previous authorization to factor the accounts receivable of CSW's subsidiaries and nonassociated utilities to December 31, 1990; and (2) Eastern Utilities Associates (EUA), a registered holding company, and EUA Cogenex Corporation (Cogenex), its wholly owned nonutility subsidiary company, for EUA, through December 31, 1991, to purchase the common stock of, and make capital contributions and/or short-term loans to, EUA Cogenex in an aggregate amount not to exceed \$30 million. EUA proposes to finance its obligations by short-term borrowings under existing bank lines of credit and from the proceeds of the public offering of additional EUA common shares, which is the subject of File No. 70-7511. Additionally, EUA Cogenex proposes to effect short-term borrowings from the EUA System's credit lines up to an aggregate amount not to exceed \$25 million, which EUA proposes to guaranty. Persons eligible to use the short form (Schedule 13G) may in lieu of filing a Schedule 13D file a Schedule 13G within 45 days after the end of the calendar year in which the person became subject to Section 13(d)(1). Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
