RULES AND RELATED MATTERS

ADOPTION OF EQUAL ACCESS TO JUSTICE ACT RULES

The SEC is adopting revised procedural rules implementing the Equal Access to Justice Act (EAJA), 5 U.S.C. 504, as amended by Public Law 99-80 (1985). The Act, in relevant part, provides for the award of attorney fees and other expenses to certain parties who prevail against the federal government in adversary adjudications before agencies. In connection with its implementation of the EAJA, the Commission is also amending its delegation of authority to its Chief Administrative Law Judge. HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

COLUMBIA GAS SYSTEM ET AL.

A supplemental order has been issued releasing jurisdiction over certain portions of a proposal by The Columbia Gas System Inc. (Columbia), a registered holding company, and certain of its wholly owned subsidiaries, including Columbia Gas of Kentucky, Inc., Columbia Gas of New York, Inc., Columbia Gas of Virginia, Inc., Commonwealth Gas Pipeline Corporation, Commonwealth Gas Services, Inc., Commonwealth Propane, Inc. and Columbia Gas System Service Corporation (Subsidiaries), whereby Columbia will increase the level of short- and long-term intrasystem financing for the Subsidiaries, and adjust the interest rate formula to be applied to previously issued variable rate debt securities. Jurisdiction has been released over all matters. (Rel. 35-24996 - Dec. 13)

NEW ENGLAND ENERGY INCORPORATED

An order has been issued authorizing a proposal by New England Energy Incorporated (NEEI), subsidiary of New England Electric System, a registered holding company, whereby NEEI will dispose of its interest in New England Collier Company (NECCO), a joint venture formed between NEEI and Keystone Shipping Co. (Keystone) to construct, own and operate a coal collier to deliver coal to New England Power Company by, among other things, renegotiating and acquiring a \$10 million note from Keystone to replace a \$10 million note of NECCO which it now holds. ORDER APPROVING PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission has approved proposed rule changes filed by: the Midwest Clearing Corporation (SR-MCC-89-11) to eliminate MCC's rule requirement that limits participation to Midwest Securities Trust Company participants and imposes a revised fee for the new category of MCC-only participants (Rel. 34-27517); and National

Association of Securities Dealers (SR-NASD-89-34) to modify Rule 59 of NASD's Uniform Practice Code, which governs buy-ins, to refine buy-in procedures and to authorize electronic notice and response methods for buy-in communications (Rel. 34-27527).

NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The National Securities Clearing Corporation (SR-NSCC-89-18) filed a proposed rule change to make a comprehensive revision of NSCC's fee structure. Publication of the notice in the Federal Register is expected during the week of December 18. (Rel. 34-27524)

Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
