## COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

---

### SEC CHAIRMAN BREEDEN NAMES THREE TO SENIOR STAFF POSITIONS

SEC Chairman Richard C. Breeden today announced the appointment of three new members of the Commission's senior staff. Marianne K. Smythe has been named Executive Assistant to the Chairman to succeed Linda D. Fienberg after her departure from the Commission this month. R. Mitchel Delk has been named Director of Legislative Affairs for the Commission. James R. Doty will become Counselor to the Chairman, a new position. (Press Rel. 90-17)

### ORDER AFFIRMING FOIA OFFICERS'S DETERMINATION TO DENY ACCESS, GRANTING AND DENYING ACCESS

The General Counsel sent a letter to Andrew J. Chao affirming the FOIA Officer's determination to deny access to certain information, and granting and denying access to certain other information not considered by the FOIA Officer. As to information considered by the FOIA Officer, the General Counsel affirmed the FOIA Officer's decision to withhold certain information on the basis of Exemption 5, 5 U.S.C. 552(b)(5). As to some of this information, the General Counsel also determined that certain forms used by the Commission's staff to examine filings would be withheld based upon Exemption 2, 5 U.S.C. 552(b)(2). As to other information not considered by the FOIA Officer, the General Counsel granted access to a final comment letter prepared by the Commission's staff, and denied access to an internal form and memorandum under Exemptions 2 and 5. ## CRIMINAL PROCEEDINGS

---

### HARVEY RUBENSTEIN SENTENCED

The Seattle Regional Office and U.S. Attorneys for the District of Oregon and the Eastern District of California announced that on March 20 the Honorable Malcolm F. Marsh, U.S. District Court Judge for Oregon, sentenced Harvey Rubenstein, a Canadian citizen of Lafayette, Oregon to four years imprisonment to be followed by five years probation on one count of securities fraud. Judge Marsh suspended sentences on another count of securities fraud and one count of wire fraud, ordering two five-year

periods of probation on those counts to run concurrently with the other five years probation. The defendant had earlier pled guilty to all three counts.

Additionally, the defendant was ordered to pay a total of \$128,375 in restitution to the three victims of the frauds and was fined a total of \$10,500. [United States v. Harvey Rubenstein, Nos. CR 85-98 (D. Or.) and CR S. 88-268 (E.D. Ca.) (Rel. LR-12432)]

## INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

---

### SMITH BARNEY, HARRIS AND UPHAM

A notice has been issued granting Smith Barney, Harris and Upham Incorporated (SBHU) a temporary order exempting it from the provisions of Section 9(a) of the Investment Company Act to relieve SBHU from any ineligibility resulting from the employment of three individuals who are subject to injunctions in Commission enforcement actions. The notice also gives interested persons until April 27 to request a hearing on SBHU's request for a permanent order of exemption. (Rel. IC-17404 - April 2)

### THE MULTIPLE ADVISERS FUND L.P. SHEARSON LEHMAN INVESTMENT STRATEGY ADVISERS INC.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until April 23 to request a hearing on an application filed by The Multiple Advisers Fund L.P. (Partnership) and Shearson Lehman Investment Strategy Advisers Inc. for a conditional order under Section 6(c) exempting the Partnership, and certain of its general and limited partners from the provisions of Sections 2(a)(19), 2(a)(3)(D) and 22(e) of the Investment Company Act. Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
