INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

PACIFIC MUTUAL LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY

An order has been issued under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act exempting Pacific Mutual Life Insurance Company, Pacific Select Variable Annuity Separate Account (Account) and Pacific Equities Network from Sections 26(a)(2)(C) and 27(c)(2) of the Act to the extent necessary to permit (1) the deduction of mortality and expense risk charges imposed under certain variable annuity contracts from the assets of the Account, and (2) the deduction from the Account's assets of a charge imposed on contracts for which a guaranteed death benefit option is elected. (Rel. IC-17488 - May 14)

ZWEIG TAX-FREE FUND

A conditional order has been issued on an application filed by Zweig Tax-Free Fund Inc., formerly DBL Tax-Free Fund Inc., amending a prior order under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act to permit the applicant to impose a contingent deferred sales charge in certain circumstances in addition to those permitted by the prior order. SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission has approved proposed rule changes filed by: New York Stock Exchange (SR-NYSE-90-01) to amend the Exchange Stock Portfolio Rules 803 and 815 and the Basket Guidelines governing discontinuous auction markets and component stock quotations in Exchange Stock Portfolios (Rel. 34-28011); and Chicago Board Options Exchange (SR-CBOE-90-04) to grant permanent approval for the CBOE's trading crowd evaluation program (Rel. 34-28012).

ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission approved on an accelerated basis a proposed rule change filed by the Midwest Stock Exchange (SR-MSE-90-05) to implement a six-month pilot program whereby the guaranteed execution price of small agency market orders received over the Midwest Automatic Execution System will be automatically improved from the consolidated best bid or offer according to certain pre-defined criteria (SuperMAX).
