CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

MUTUAL FUND SUED

On August 8, the Fort Worth Regional Office announced the filing of a civil action against Carl L. Lazzell (Lazzell), David H. Ward (Ward), and Edward J. Carter (Carter). Lazzell is a resident of San Antonio, Texas, and both Ward and Carter are Canadian residents. The action seeks injunctive relief against the defendants to prevent further violations of the antifraud provisions of the federal securities laws and disgorgement.

The Commission's Complaint alleges that the defendants systematically looted a mutual fund, the Prospector Fund, a series of the United Services Funds, by causing Prospector to repeatedly deviate from its investment policies by purchasing approximately \$20 million of over-valued securities secretly controlled by the two Canadians. Prospector suffered approximately \$15 million in trading losses before the looting was discovered. Lazzell, the former portfolio manager of Prospector, received in excess of \$1 million in secret "kickbacks" from Ward and Carter for his efforts. FOR FURTHER INFORMATION, CONTACT: T. HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

NATIONAL FUEL GAS COMPANY

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until September 4 to request a hearing on a proposal by National Fuel Gas Company, a registered holding company, and its subsidiary, Enerop Corporation (Enerop), whereby Enerop will invest in Metscan, Inc. (Metscan), a company which develops and markets certain gas meter reading technology. Enerop's investment will include the acquisition of 143,000 shares of Metscan common stock for a price of \$357,500, and of 39,500 shares of its preferred stock for a price of \$158,000. INDIANA MICHIGAN POWER COMPANY

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until September 4 to request a hearing on a proposal by Indiana Michigan Power Company, an electric public-utility subsidiary company of American Electric Power Company, Inc., a registered holding company, to sell certain of its assets to Wabash Valley Power Association, Inc. for a cash purchase price of \$1,370,075. The assets to be sold consist of electric power facilities and other related equipment as are located on real estate owned by General Motors Corporation. (Rel. 35-25131)

KINGSPORT POWER COMPANY

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until September 4 to request a hearing on a proposal by Kingsport Power Company and Wheeling Power Company, both electric public-utility subsidiary companies of American Electric Power Company, Inc., a registered holding company, to issue prior to December 31, 1990, unsecured promissory notes in an aggregate principal amount not exceeding \$2 million and \$11 million, respectively, pursuant to a proposed term loan agreement. BLACKSTONE VALLEY ELECTRIC COMPANY

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until September 4 to request a hearing on a proposal by Blackstone Valley Electric Company (BVEC), an electric public-utility subsidiary of Eastern Utilities Associates, a registered holding company, to amend the terms of its outstanding preferred stock to permit, for a period of 5 years, unsecured debt having maturities of less than ten years in amounts in excess of an amount equal to 10% of the sum of BVEC's secured debt, capital and surplus. IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The following proposed rule changes have become immediately effective pursuant to Rule 19b-4 of the Securities Exchange Act: Intermarket Clearing Corporation (SR-ICC-90-05) relating to an amendment to its rules implementing Commodity Futures Trading Commission's Regulation 1.63 (Rel. 34-28325); and Stock Clearing Corporation of Philadelphia (SR-SCCP-90-01) to modify SCCP's fees (Re. 34-28326). Publication of the notices is expected in the Federal Register during the week of August 13.

PROPOSED RULE CHANGE AND ACCELERATED PARTIAL APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Boston Stock Exchange (SR-BSE-90-11) filed a proposed rule change under Rule 19b-4 seeking permanent approval of a rule establishing procedures for reviewing proposed combinations among specialist units and the Commission granted accelerated approval of the BSE's proposal to renew its specialist concentration pilot program for one year (Rel. 34-28327). Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of August 13.
