ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

PROCEEDING INSTITUTED AGAINST STOTLER AND COMPANY

The Commission announced the institution of public administrative proceedings against Stotler and Company of Chicago, Illinois. The Order Instituting Public Proceedings (Order) alleges that Stotler, a registered government securities broker-dealer, wilfully violated certain provisions of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Treasury Rules in that it effected transactions in or induced or attempted to induce the purchase or sale of government securities while not a member of a securities association registered under Section 15A of the Exchange Act, failed to have and maintain the required amount of net capital, failed to deposit the required funds in a special reserve bank account for customers, failed to accurately make and keep current records of net capital computations and long and short securities positions, failed to prepare and file financial reports with the Commission, and failed to comply with the telegraphic notice requirements.

A hearing will be scheduled to take evidence on the staff's allegations and to afford Respondent an opportunity to present any defenses thereto. (Rel. 34-28360)

CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

COMPLAINT AGAINST PROFIT ENTERPRISES

The Commission announced the filing of a Complaint for Injunctive and Other Relief in the U.S. District Court for the District of Columbia against Profit Enterprises, Inc. (Profit), Jerry J. Savage and Dixie L. Savage.

The Complaint alleges the defendants violated Section 5(a) and (c) of the Securities Act of 1933 by offering unregistered securities in the form of fractional undivided interests in three oil and gas partnerships: the Whitfield 1A, purportedly located in Texas, and the Sinclair 1-A and Sinclair 2-A, purportedly located in Alaska. The Complaint alleges that Sinclair wells did not exist and that Profit had no ownership interest in the Whitfield 1A well. The Complaint also alleges that the offers and sales were made by means of material misrepresentations in violation of Section 17(a) of the Securities Act and Section 10(b) of the Exchange Act and Rule 10b-5 promulgated thereunder. The Complaint further alleges that Jerry J. Savage and Dixie L. Savage effected transactions in securities for the accounts of others without having registered with the Commission as broker-dealers in violation of Section 15(a) of the Exchange Act. [SEC v. INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES
