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## **ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS**

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### **HERBERT STONE BARRED**

The Commission instituted public administrative proceedings against Herbert Stone, formerly a registered representative of a Florida-based registered broker-dealer, pursuant to Sections 15(b) and 19(h) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 (Exchange Act).

Stone submitted an Offer of Settlement consenting to the entry of an Order, which contains findings that Stone: (1) is presently permanently enjoined from violations of the antifraud provisions of the Securities Act of 1933 and the antifraud provisions of the Exchange Act, by judgment of the U.S. District Court for the Central District of California in connection with his participation in a nationwide stock manipulation (SEC v. Magna Technologies, Inc., et al., Civil Action No. 87-2895 MRP (GX)); and (2) was convicted upon a plea of guilty in the U.S. District Court for the Northern District of Illinois, of numerous felony counts of securities and mail fraud, and other charges, in connection with his participation in the manipulation of the market for the common stock of European Auto Classics, Ltd. (U.S. v. Jack Ringer, et al., (Criminal Action No. 86 CR 541)). The Order also permanently bars Stone from association with any broker, dealer, municipal securities dealer, transfer agent, investment adviser or investment company. (Rel. 34-28350)

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## **CIVIL PROCEEDINGS**

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### **INJUNCTIONS AGAINST PACIFIC EQUITIES AND OTHERS**

The Fort Worth Regional Office announced that, on August 20, Judge David O. Belew, Jr., U.S. District Court for the Northern District of Texas, issued an order of permanent injunction against Pacific Equities Corporation, G. Alfred Roensch, and Owen K. Stephenson, all of San Francisco, California. The order enjoins them from further violations of the registration, antifraud, and ownership and periodic reporting provisions of the securities laws. Defendants consented to the orders without admitting or denying the Commission's allegations. Defendants were further ordered to pay disgorgement in the amount of \$20,304.90, which has been paid.

The November 21, 1989 Complaint alleges that nine defendants violated the registration and antifraud provisions by offering and selling unregistered shares of U.S. General Corporation (USGC). In connection with these offers and sales, the Complaint alleges that defendants made false and misleading statements of material facts concerning the financial condition and business prospects of USGC, and its ownership, and violated the ownership and periodic reporting provisions of the Exchange Act. #### CONTEMPT MOTIONS FILED AGAINST ROBERT PALLE, JR. AND JAMES LUKSCH

The Los Angeles Regional Office announced that, on August 21, the Commission filed Motions for Judgment of Civil Contempt against Robert J. Palle, Jr. (Palle) and James A. Luksch (Luksch) based upon their failure to pay disgorgement and civil penalties under the Insider Trading Sanctions Act of 1984 (ITSA).

Orders entered on June 20, 1989, against Palle and Luksch require each to disgorge amounts corresponding to their losses avoided from sales of Texscan stock while allegedly in possession of material non-public information concerning Texscan's financial condition and to pay civil penalties under ITSA. The Commission's contempt motions are predicated on Palle's failure to pay disgorgement in the amount of \$6,208 and a penalty of \$6,208, and Luksch's failure to pay \$12,143.50 in disgorgement and a penalty of \$12,143.50. All seven defendants, including Palle and Luksch, were previously permanently enjoined from future violations of the antifraud, reporting, and books and records provisions of federal securities laws. 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#### CRIMINAL PROCEEDINGS

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#### RACKETEERING INDICTMENT NAMES FIVE

The Los Angeles Regional Office announced that, on August 15, a Federal Grand Jury sitting in Albuquerque, New Mexico, returned a two count Indictment against Samuel A. Francis, Roland "Buddy" Othick, Sandra Hindi Othick, Robert Redmer and Rudy Marich, charging racketeering and conspiracy to violate racketeering laws, Title 18, United States Code, Section 1962(c) and (d). Additionally, Roland Othick and Redmer were also charged with a third count of witness tampering, Title 18, United States Code, Section 1512. The target crimes of the racketeering enterprise included mail fraud, securities fraud in violation of Section 17(a) of the Securities Act of 1933, Section 10(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Rule 10b-5 thereunder, and witness tampering. The Indictment alleges the existence of a racketeering enterprise from 1977 to 1988, involving four penny stock corporations, Radtech, Inc., Hal-Rad Communications, Inc., T.O.N.M. Oil and Gas Exploration Corp., Hallicrafters Equipment Company, Inc., Allison Securities, Inc., Nielson and Clark Inc., and R.B. Marich, Inc. [U.S. v. Samuel A. Francis, et al., CR-No. 90-329, (U.S.D.C., District of New Mexico)] (LR-12593)
