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U.S. SECURITIES AND
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ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

ROBERT E. ILES, SR., BARRED

Chief Administrative Law Judge Warren E. Blair issued an initial decision barring Robert E. Iles, Sr., of Edgewater, Florida, from association with a broker or dealer or an investment adviser.

Judge Blair found that Robert E. Iles, Sr., had wilfully violated Section 10(b) of the Securities Exchange Act and Rule 10b-5 thereunder in connection with the purchase and sale of common stock of Dupont Instruments, Inc. during the period from May 1985 to September 1986. Additionally, he was found to have been permanently enjoined on June 21, 1989, by the U.S. District Court for the Middle District of Florida from future violations of Section 10(b) and Rule 10b-5 thereunder, and convicted in May 1988 in the U.S. District Court for the Southern District of Ohio of, among other felonies, filing a false federal income tax return and aiding and abetting the preparation of false income tax returns. (Initial Decision Rel. No. 8)

MICHAEL FEE SUSPENDED

Administrative Law Judge Jerome K. Soffer has issued an initial decision suspending Michael J. Fee of Drexel Hill, Pennsylvania, from association with any broker or dealer for a period of 90 days.

The sanction imposed was based upon findings that Fee, while associated as a registered representative with a broker-dealer, violated the anti-fraud provisions of the securities laws in connection with the sale of the common stock of Airwave Communications Corporation of America, a so-called "penny stock", without having a sound and adequate basis for his recommendation that his customers purchase this stock. (Initial Decision Rel. No. 9)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

CREDIT SUISSE, BEA ASSOCIATES

A conditional order has been issued pursuant to Section 9(c) of the Investment Company Act exempting Credit Suisse, BEA Associates and all persons now or hereafter affiliated with Credit Suisse from the provisions of Section 9(a) of the Act arising as a result of injunctions entered against Credit Suisse and an affiliate of Credit Suisse. The Order is conditioned on Credit Suisse's undertaking that it will not employ any of the individuals referred to in the complaints leading to entry of the injunctions in any capacity related directly to the provision of investment advisory services for registered investment companies or to acting as a principal underwriter for a registered open-end investment company or as a principal underwriter or depositor for a unit investment trust without first making further application to the Commission. (Rel. IC-17813 - October 23)
