## TRADING SUSPENSIONS

### TRADING IN THE SECURITIES OF ELECTRONIC MEDICAL MANAGEMENT SUSPENDED

The Atlanta Regional and Miami Branch Offices announced that on November 13 the Commission temporarily suspended over-the-counter trading in the securities of Electronic Medical Management, Inc. (EMMI), a Nevada corporation, for the ten business day period commencing at 9:30 a.m. (EST) on November 13, 1990 and terminating at 11:59 a.m. (EST) on November 27, 1990.

The Commission temporarily suspended trading in the securities of EMMI because of the lack of adequate current information concerning the company, and in view of questions that have been raised about the adequacy and accuracy of publicly disseminated information concerning, among other things, the history and formation of EMMI, the public tradeability of EMMI stock, the background of its promoters and other matters.

## SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

### PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

Proposed rule changes have been filed by the following under Rule 19b-4 of the Securities Exchange Act: National Securities Clearing Corporation (SR-NSCC-90-23) relating to the elimination of its Correspondent Delivery and Collection Service (Rel. 34-28599); and Government Securities Clearing Corporation (SR-GSCC-90-06) to allow GSCC to include in its netting system zero coupon government securities (Rel. 34-28603). Publication of the proposed rule changes is expected in the Federal Register during the week of November 12.

### IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

On October 24, the Government Securities Clearing Corporation filed with the Commission a proposed rule change (SR-GSCC-90-07), which has become effective immediately, to change the fees charged by GSCC for clearance services. Publication of the proposal in the Federal Register is expected during the week of November 12. (Rel. 34-28604)
