COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

FEE RATE ADVISORY #7

The Congress has passed, and will soon send to the President for signature, H.R. 1088, the "Investor and Capital Markets Relief Act." If signed by the President, this Act would substantially reduce the fee rates under Section 6(b) of the Securities Act of 1933 and Sections 13(e), 14(g), and 31 of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. The fee rates under Securities Act Section 6(b) and Exchange Act Sections 13(e) and 14(g) would decline to \$92 per \$1,000,000 effective October 1, 2001. The fee rates under Exchange Act Section 31 would decline to \$15 per \$1,000,000 effective December 28, 2001. In addition, as of such date, Section 31 fees would no longer apply to sales of options on securities indexes (other than narrow-based security indexes).

JOINT PRESS RELEASE BY SEC AND CFTC

Securities and Exchange Commission Chairman Harvey L. Pitt and Commodity Futures Trading Commission Chairman James E. Newsome jointly pledged to seek prompt agency adoption of final rules relating to security futures products, pursuant to authorization of such products by the Commodity Futures Modernization Act of 2000 (CFMA).

Chairmen Pitt and Newsome expressed confidence that they would promptly achieve consensus on remaining issues to allow security futures products to trade in a fair and competitive manner at the earliest possible date, while avoiding regulatory arbitrage between the options and futures markets. Chairmen Pitt and Newsome also noted that they are committed to ensuring customer protection and encouraging innovation and new product development quickly.

Chairmen Pitt and Newsome committed their agencies to work toward promulgating final rules relating to margin on these products, as well as rules relating to protection of customer funds, that would allow trading by the public of security futures products by early in the second quarter 2002.

The Chairmen have agreed that, in light of the comments received by the Commissions, the agencies will jointly work to adopt a stand-alone margin rule to govern the conduct of financial relations with respect to security futures carried in a futures account.

Chairmen Pitt and Newsome also agreed that the CFMA does not require, by its terms, that implementation of portfolio margining for security futures be deferred until it has been approved for exchange-traded options, provided that the essential goal of avoiding regulatory arbitrage between security futures and exchange-traded options is achieved.

With regard to foreign security index products, Chairmen Pitt and Newsome agreed to move forward promptly in this area in accordance with the requirements of the CFMA. They have instructed their staffs to address these issues, and expect to announce proposals in the near future on several matters relating to foreign security index products. (Press Rel. 2001-152)

RULES AND RELATED MATTERS

EQUITY COMPENSATION DISCLOSURE

On December 19, the Commission adopted amendments to its rules and forms under the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 to enhance company disclosure of employee stock option plans and other equity compensation arrangements. Starting in the second half of next year, companies will have to provide detailed information about their equity compensation plans in a new table in their annual reports on Forms 10-K and 10-KSB filed with the SEC. This information will also have to be included in a company's proxy or information statement in years in which the company is submitting a compensation plan for security holder approval. The table will include the number and weighted-average exercise price of outstanding options, warrants and rights, and the number of securities available for future issuance under a company's existing equity compensation plans. The new disclosure will be given separately for plans that have been approved by security holders and plans that have not been approved by security holders. (Rel. 33-8048; 34-45189)

ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS

JUDGMENT ENTERED AGAINST GLENN PERDUE IN CONNECTION WITH PRIME BANK OFFERING

The Commission announced the entry of a judgment by consent in the United States District Court for the Middle District of Florida against Glenn Perdue of Indianapolis, Indiana. The Commission's complaint alleged that Perdue acted as a sales agent for Earl A. Abbott, a Titusville, Florida businessman by selling \$3 million of non-existent prime bank securities to investors. Perdue, the Commission alleged, entered into joint venture agreements promising investors a weekly return of 2% over forty weeks, or 80%. The Commission alleged that Perdue made material misrepresentations to investors concerning the existence of the trading program; the use of investor funds; the promised return; and the safety of the funds invested.

The Court entered a Permanent Injunction prohibiting Perdue from violating the securities registration, antifraud and broker-dealer registration provisions of the Securities Act of 1933 and the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. The Commission did not allege that Perdue received any sales commission or profits and according the Commission did not seek disgorgement. Perdue agreed, without admitting or denying the Commission's allegations, to settle the action by agreeing to the entry of the injunction. Based on Perdue's sworn representations in his

statement of financial condition and other documents submitted to the Commission, the Commission is not imposing a civil monetary penalty against Perdue. [SEC v. Earl A. Abbott, et al., Civil Action No. 6:01- CV-364-ORL-31-KRS, USDC, MDFL] (LR-17289)

SEC HALTS FRAUDULENT SALE OF CHARITABLE ANNUITIES, FREEZES ASSETS

On December 20, upon the Commission's request, Judge James A. Teilborg, of the United States District Court for the District of Arizona (Phoenix Division), issued a Temporary Restraining Order against defendants Robert R. Dillie and Mid-America Foundation, Inc., and an asset freeze and other relief against the defendants and the relief defendant, Mid-America Financial Group, Inc., in connection with the sale of Charitable Gift Annuities (CGAs) for an estimated \$54 million. The court further appointed a receiver over their assets.

In its action, the Commission accuses Dillie and the Foundation of violating the anti-fraud provisions of the federal securities laws in connection with their sale of CGAs since 1997, primarily to elderly investors seeking a safe, steady income, tax benefits, and charitable donations. Although Dillie and the Foundation claimed that the CGAs were backed by conservatively invested assets, Dillie and the Foundation instead misappropriated most, if not all, of the CGA sale proceeds, to pay for Dillie's extravagant lifestyle and gambling debts. GREENWICH STREET EMPLOYEES FUND, L.P., ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until January 15, 2002, to request a hearing on an application filed by Greenwich Street Employees Fund, L.P., et al. for an order under Sections 6(b) and 6(e) of the Investment Company Act in connection with the formation of limited partnerships and other entities (each a Partnership) to be offered to certain key employees of Citigroup Inc. and its affiliates. Each Partnership will be an employees' securities company within the meaning of Section 2(a)(13) of the Act. (Rel. IC-25324 - December 21)

ONE FUND, INC., OHIO NATIONAL FUND, INC., DOW TARGET VARIABLE FUND LLC, AND OHIO NATIONAL INVESTMENTS, INC.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until January 15, 2002, to request a hearing on an application filed by One Fund, Inc., Ohio National Fund, Inc., Dow Target Variable Fund LLC, and Ohio National Investments, Inc. for an order under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act for an exemption from Section 15(a) of the Act and rule 18f-2 under the Act. The order would permit applicants to enter into and materially amend sub-advisory agreements without shareholder approval. (Rel. IC-25325 - December 21)

HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

ENERGY EAST CORPORATION

A supplemental order has been issued authorizing a proposal by Energy East Corporation (Energy East), a registered holding company. By order dated October 13, 2000 (HCAR No. 27248) (Order) the Commission, among other things: (1) designated Energy East Management Corp. (EE Management) as a subsidiary service company of Energy East in accordance with the provisions of rule 88; (2) authorized the delay, to a date no later than December 31, 2001 (Transition Period), the full implementation of all expected services to be provided by EE Management; and/or (3) authorized the delay of the full implementation of the required service agreements. This supplemental order extends the Transition Period under the Order to November 30, 2002. (Rel. 35-27481)

E.ON AG, ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until January 17, 2002, to request a hearing on a proposal by (i) E.ON AG (E.ON), a German holding company exempt from registration by Rule 5 under the Act; (ii) Powergen plc (Powergen), a U.K. registered holding company; and (iii) Powergen's direct and indirect wholly owned registered holding company subsidiaries Powergen US Holdings Limited, Powergen US Investments, Powergen Luxembourg sarl, Powergen Luxembourg Holdings sarl, Powergen Luxembourg Investments sarl, Powergen US Investments Corp. (collectively, Applicants). Applicants request authority for E.ON to acquire Powergen (Acquisition), and thereby acquire Powergen's indirect wholly owned subsidiary LG&E Energy Corp. (LG&E Energy) a Kentucky holding company exempt from registration under Section 3(a)(1) of the Act, and LG&E Energy's utility subsidiaries Louisville Gas and Electric Company and Kentucky Utilities Company. Applicants also request authorization to engage in financing for the purpose of acquiring foreign utility companies and exempt wholesale generators, as defined in Sections 32 and 33 of the Act, and other transactions related and subsequent to the Acquisition. Following the Acquisition, E.ON intends to register under Section 5 of the Act. (Rel. 35-27482; International Release Series No. 1253)
