ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS

CRAIG RYAN SPRADLING CONSENTS TO RELIEF SOUGHT IN INSIDER TRADING ACTION

On March 25, the Commission announced that Craig Ryan Spradling (Spradling), formerly an associate at a prominent law firm, has agreed to settle charges that he engaged in insider trading. On June 11, 1998, the Commission filed a complaint alleging that Spradling, while an associate at the New York office of Cleary, Gottlieb, Steen & Hamilton (Cleary) in October 1996, bought options to purchase common stock of Loctite Corporation (Loctite) when Spradling knew that Loctite was the target of a tender offer being planned by a client of Cleary.

Without admitting or denying the allegations, Spradling has consented to the entry of a final judgment permanently enjoining Spradling from committing securities fraud and tender offer fraud in violation of Sections 10(b) and 14(e) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Rules 10b-5 and 14e-3; and ordering Spradling to

disgorge \$49,312.50 in illegal trading profits and \$10,429.48 in prejudgment interest. Under the terms of the final judgment, which has been submitted to the court for approval, payment of \$6,102.47 in prejudgment interest would be waived and no civil penalty would be imposed based upon Spradling's demonstrated inability to pay.

Spradling earlier pleaded guilty to criminal charges arising from the same conduct. On January 15, 1999, Spradling was sentenced to a term of probation for three years, including six months of home detention, and fined \$3,000.

HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

NEW ENGLAND ELECTRIC SYSTEM

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until April 19, 1999 to request a hearing on a proposal by New England Electric System (NEES), a registered holding company, in connection with the proposed merger of NEES and The National Grid Group plc, for NEES to amend its trust agreement to allow the merger and to give shareholders certain appraisal rights. An order has been issued authorizing NEES to solicit proxies from its common shareholders to obtain required approval of the merger and of the amendment to the trust agreement. (Rel. 35-26994)

SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Pacific Stock Exchange filed with the Commission a proposed rule change under Rule 19b-4 (SR-PCX-99-02) Relating to Matters Subject to Arbitration. Publication of the notice in the Federal Register is expected during the week of March 29. (Rel. 34-41206)

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission approved a proposed rule change submitted under Rule 19b-4 by the National Association of Securities Dealers (SR-NASD-98-59) to change the Association's trade reporting rules. (Rel. 34-41208)

ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The Commission granted accelerated approval to a proposed rule change (SR-BSE-99-3) filed by the Boston Stock Exchange to modify "collar" procedures that limit index arbitrage during times of market volatility, and to eliminate "sidecar" procedures that restrict stop and stop limit orders during times of market

volatility. Those rule changes are based on recently approved rule changes by the New York Stock Exchange. Publication of the notice and order is expected in the Federal Register during the week of March 29. (Rel. 34-41200)

The Commission granted accelerated approval to a proposed rule change submitted by the Philadelphia Stock Exchange (SR-Phlx-99-06) under Rule 19b-4 of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 relating to Mandatory Trading Floor Training Requirements. Publication of the notice in the Federal Register is expected during the week of March 29. (Rel. 34-41201)
