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## ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS

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### IN THE MATTER OF JOHN KENNY AND NICHOLSON/KENNY CAPITAL MANAGEMENT, INC.

Administrative Law Judge Stephen L. Grossman issued an Initial Decision today in the above referenced matter. The Division of Enforcement alleged that, beginning in 1993 and continuing to at least November 1995, Mr. Kenny, in league with Robert C. Wilson, engaged in a scheme to defraud investors.

The Decision finds that Mr. Kenny violated Section 17(a) of the Securities Act of 1933 (Securities Act), Section 10(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 (Exchange Act) and Rule 10b-5 thereunder, and Sections 206 of the Investment Advisers Act of 1940 (Advisers Act). The Decision also finds that Mr. Kenny aided and abetted Mr. Wilson's violations of the securities laws. The Decision further finds that Nicholson/Kenny Capital Management, Inc. (Nicholson/Kenny) violated Section 206 of the Advisers Act.

The Decision orders Mr. Kenny to cease and desist from committing or causing any violations of Section 17(a) of the Securities Act, Section 10(b) of the Exchange Act and Rule 10b-5 thereunder, and Sections 206 of the Advisers Act. Nicholson/Kenny was also ordered to cease and desist from committing or causing any violations of Section 206 Advisers Act. The Decision also orders that, pursuant to Section 15(b)(6) of the Exchange Act and Section 203(f) of the Advisers Act, Mr. Kenny is barred from being associated with any broker, dealer, or investment adviser, and the investment adviser registration of Nicholson/Kenny is revoked. The Decision further orders that Mr. Kenny and Nicholson/Kenny pay disgorgement, jointly and severally, in the amount of \$1,333,000 together with prejudgment interest. Finally, the Decision orders that Mr. Kenny pay civil money penalties in the amount of \$700,000 and Nicholson/Kenny pay civil money penalties in the amount of \$500,000. ### COMMISSION DENIES RECONSIDERATION REQUEST OF LAURIE CANADY

The Commission has denied the request of Laurie Jones Canady, formerly a salesperson with the Davenport, Iowa branch of Merrill Lynch, for reconsideration of a Commission decision dated April 5,

1999. In denying her request, the Commission rejected Canady's contention that the proceedings were barred by the statute of limitations, finding that the defense had been waived because it was not timely raised. The Commission further denied Canady's request to adduce additional evidence, finding that Canady failed to establish that the evidence was material and that there were reasonable grounds for her failure to introduce it earlier, as required by Commission rules. ## **SEC FINDS ATLANTA-BASED INVESTMENT ADVISER COMMITTED FRAUD**

The Commission announced today that it issued an Order Making Findings, Imposing Remedial Sanctions, and Imposing Cease and Desist Orders Pursuant to Sections 203(e), 203(f), and 203(k) of the Investment Advisers Act against Bell Capital Management, Inc. (Bell Capital), an Atlanta-based registered investment adviser, its President, Ronnie H. Bell (Bell), and two of its vice Presidents, Thomas C. Comsudes (Comsudes), and Mark S. Palmer (Palmer).

The order instituting public proceedings on September 30, 1998, alleged that Bell Capital's primary marketing tool, a brochure, was false and misleading in that: (1) the performance results contained therein did not prominently disclose the effect of the deduction of advisory and other fees on performance results; (2) the brochure, for some of the years listed, failed to disclose the effect of material market and economic conditions on those performance results; and (3) the brochure did not prominently disclose that some of the performance results contained in it were hypothetical and others were actual. The Order further alleged that Bell Capital did not have the documents necessary to support the performance figures contained in its brochure.

The Commission accepted the Offer of Settlement of Bell Capital, Bell, Comsudes, and Palmer, in which, without admitting or denying the Commission's findings except those pertaining to jurisdiction, they consented to the entry of the Order. The Order finds that Bell Capital violated the antifraud provisions of the Investment Advisers Act (Advisers Act) and that Bell, Comsudes, and Palmer aided and abetted it in those violations. The Order also finds that Bell Capital violated the record-keeping provisions of the Advisers Act, requires Bell Capital to pay a \$15,000 civil penalty, to retain a consultant to review its marketing brochure and method of calculating the performance of its portfolios, and to give notice of the Order to its current and prospective clients. The Order also censures Bell Capital, Bell, Comsudes, and Palmer, requires each of the individuals to pay a \$10,000 civil penalty, and provides for the entry of cease and desist orders against them.
